New York City has some of the world's most vibrant tech industries with over 7,500 tech firms supporting 291,000 jobs, all fueled by increased venture funding—\$4.5B in 2014 alone.

Design

A global design capital, New York City boasts more practicing designers than any other US city—40,000, over 3,900 design firms and 10 design and architecture schools, ensuring a pipeline of new talent.

Manufacturing

Thanks to City investment, the manufacturing industry is booming, with over 5,700 manufacturing establishments employing over 75K people.

Combining traditional print and emerging digital, NYC is the capital of content publishing. The book publishing industry is based in NYC, as are 350 consumer magazines and online giants like Gawker Media, Huffington Post, BuzzFeed and Vice Media.

Real Estate

Globally recognized skyscrapers are the crown jewels of the US's largest real estate market, which features over 550 million square feet of commercial office space.

Fashion & Beauty

New York City is the center of the global fashion industry, with more global beauty companies headquartered here than any other city, more fashion showrooms—over 5,000—than any other city, over 75 fashion trade shows a year, and over 1,000 fashion school students graduating each year, ensuring a strong talent pipeline.


Life Sciences
