You can go hundreds of km on skis in Ål in Hallingdal, with panoramic views of Hallingskarvet and Reineskarvet.

Many lean-tos have been set out and grill places established for a rest along the way, with ski games for the youngest.

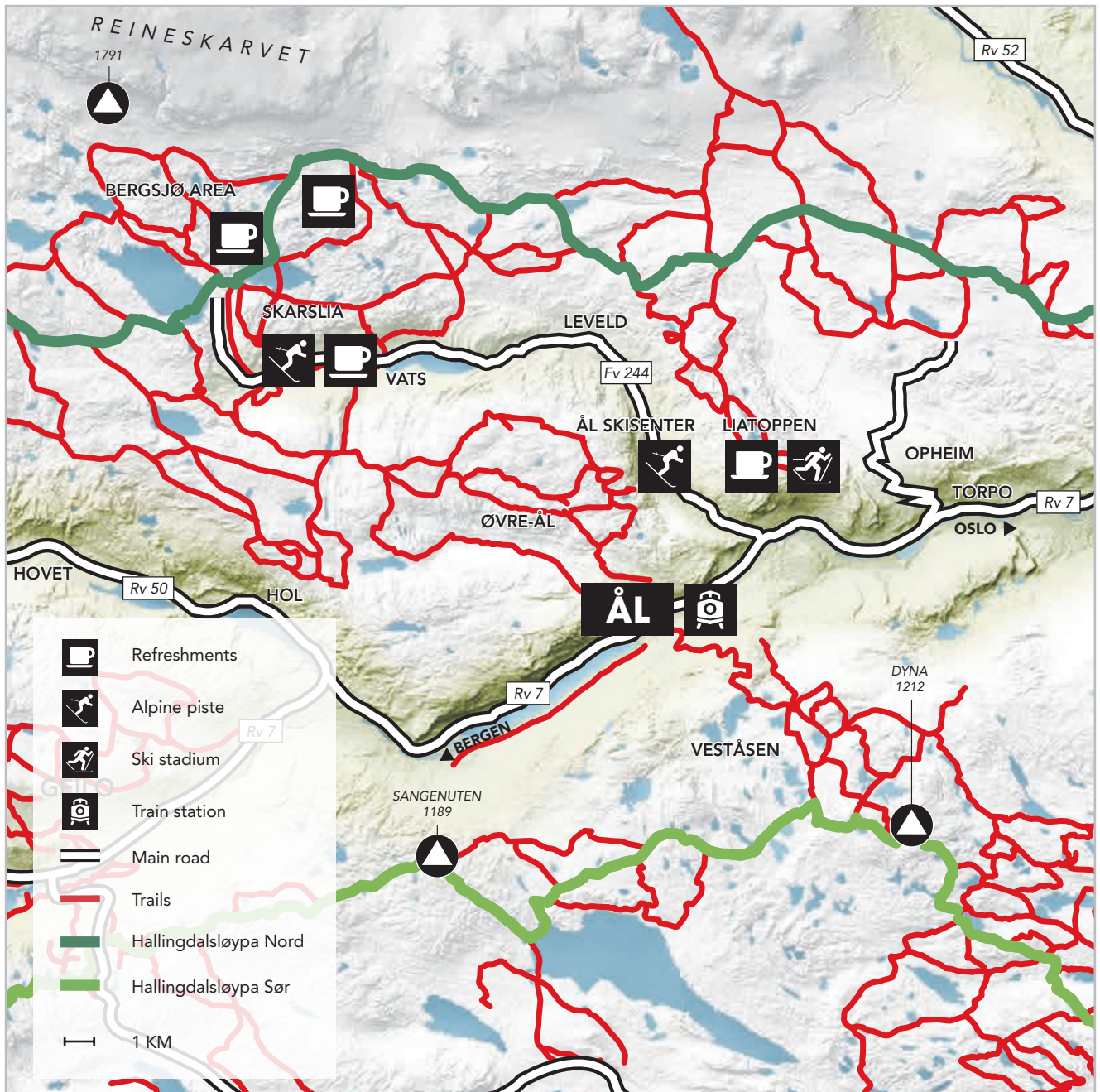
Liatoppen skisenter

Skisporet.no always has updated information about when and where all cross-country trails are prepared.











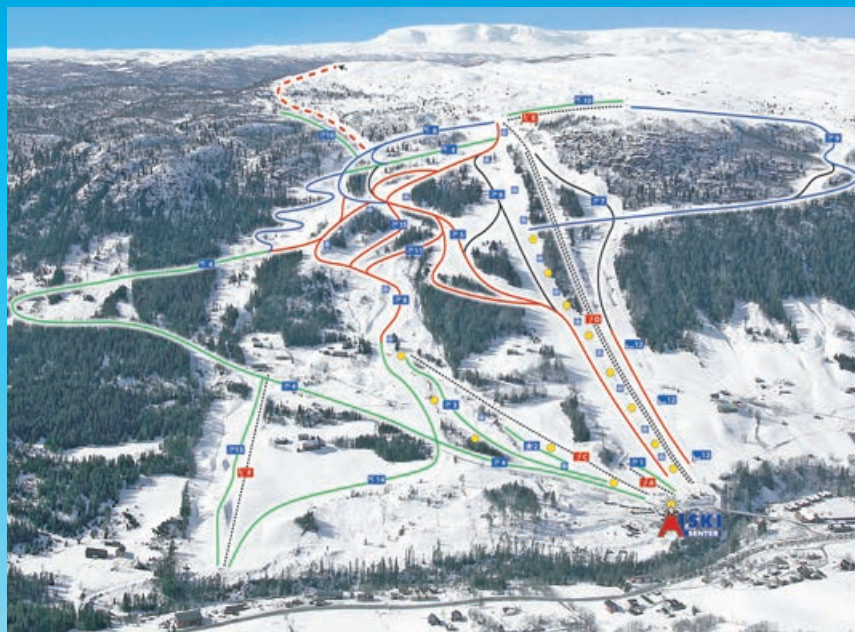
Skarslia Ski- og akesenter

An adventure for everyone! With two of Norway's longest sledding hills, speed and excitement come easily. Here there is also great alpine skiing or cross-country skiing. The grill cabins have space for 50 persons and can be hired for various occasions.



Ål Skisenter

A ski centre situated in Votndalen, 7 km from the centre of Ål. It is a wonderful area for children and families, a jibbing park and trails of all degrees of difficulty. If you wish to hire skis and a trainer, you can also do this. Ål Skisenter is renowned for Svartebergløypa, one of Norway's best giant slalom slopes.







Dog sledding

Want speed and excitement? Join us for a fantastic outdoor adventure with dogs that will take you on a trip into the mountains. Dog sledding is suitable for the entire family and just fun for everyone.





Kiting

The Bergsjø area is ideal for kiting in winter. Bergsjøstølen Fjellstue holds kiting courses throughout the winter. Sign up to join a weekend course here, or a half-day course if you would prefer this.







Ice fishing

Vatsfjorden and Rødungen in the Bergsjø area are considered among Norway's best ice fishing lakes. Fishing cards may be purchased at self-service boxes near the fishing area.

Skating rinks in Ål

All ages can challenge themselves on the ice with speed and excitement. In Hallingdal Feriepark and in the school park in the centre of Ål, ice skating is available for everyone. Bergsjø has natural ice when the conditions are right for it.
