District: Coliseum Industrial Area/Airport


Oracle Arena is an indoor arena in Oakland, California, located in the Coliseum Industrial area near Oakland International Airport. It was originally constructed as the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum Arena in 1966 and is the home of the Golden State Warriors, world-class concerts and special events.

Capacity: 20,000

FEATURES

- Oracle Arena is the premiere sports and entertainment venue in Northern California
- Oracle Arena hosts family shows, concerts, sporting events and special events
- The arena includes 72 luxury suites and 3 exclusive clubs
- Electronic scoreboard

O.co Coliseum is the only multi-purpose stadium to serve as a full-time home to both a Major League Baseball team (the Oakland Athletics) and a National Football League team (the Oakland Raiders) in the United States.

JAMTOWN is a premium indoor basketball and volleyball venue. We host tournaments, camps and clinics and offer open shooting, basketball skills training (with professional trainers), shoot-away basketball machine rental, court rentals, and league play. Jamtown can host sports competitions of virtually any type (basketball, volleyball, futsal, wrestling, martial arts, cheer, etc.)

Capacity: 30,000 square feet of court space with approximately 10,000 sq. ft. of interior space, including a mezzanine viewing area. Up to 800 people in the main space including players and spectators.

- 4 brand new 84 x 50 bio-cushioned maple hardwood courts with bright center court logos and matching wall-mounted scoreboards
- 24 baskets including NBA portable hoops at the baselines
- State of the art Draper volleyball equipment & referee stands

Located in the heart of downtown Oakland, the Oakland Convention Center is just 15 minutes from downtown San Francisco. With 45,960 square feet of unobstructed space, the East and West Halls can accommodate gymnastic tournaments, wrestling events, roller derby and more. Portable staging and seating is available as needed.

Capacity: 64,000 square feet with an additional 25,000 in the attached hotel

OAKLAND ICE CENTER OPERATED BY SHARKS ICE





Sharks Ice at Oakland is the newest ice skating facility in California to be operated by the San Jose Sharks of the NHL. It is a state of the art ice facility located in Uptown Oakland that hosts hundreds of events annually including National Championship hockey tournaments, over-the-top corporate events and more.

LANEY COLLEGE

District: Downtown/Lake Merritt

The flagship of the Peralta Community College District, Laney College stretches across sixty acres in the lively center of resurgent downtown Oakland. Laney College stands alongside the Oakland Museum of California, just a few blocks from Lake Merritt. Bay Area Rapid Transit and AC Transit provide convenient transportation to the school and its surrounding public facilities. Laney College offers facility rentals and the professional services needed to present conferences, workshops, sporting events, and stage performances. The college can accommodate a variety of sporting events for groups as few as 10 people to 1,500 people or more. Services include IT support, Audio Visual technical support and equipment, catering and custodial services.

The award winning Field House offers adjacent state-ofthe-art training and dressing rooms as well as classroom space. Carefully sited adjacent to the football field and the new baseball diamond, the Field House anchors all of Laney College's athletic resources. The LEED Gold project incorporates a range of site-specific sustainable design features, including a bio-swale, solar array, and cool roof materials to reduce the heat island effect.

- Award winning LEED athletic facility with state of the art training & dressing rooms
- Aquatic Facilities include 25yd 8 lane competitive deep pool, 25yd - 3 lane shallow pool, (2) 1-meter diving boards, (1) 3-meter diving board and overhead bleacher seating
- Gymnasium with electronic scoreboard, bleachers and locker room
- New state of the art baseball diamond with bleacher seating and electronic scoreboard
- Football field with bleacher seating
- Track & Field facilities

This beautiful turf field stadium, nestled in the rolling hills, is adjacent to the East Bay Regional Park. It is an inspiring location for soccer, track, and rugby games.

Capacity:

Gymnasium seats 1200 spectators

Turf Soccer Field with seating for 750 spectators

MILLS COLLEGE

District: Oakland Hills

Located in the foothills of Oakland, California, Mills College offers a spectacular environment for hosting athletic events, special events, or trainings. The soccer field, tennis courts, pool, gymnasium, activity room, and classroom are available for rent.

Capacity:

- · Regulation size soccer field
- · Six tennis courts with lights
- Three quarter length gymnasium with bleacher seating
- 25-yard pool with 10 competition lanes, shallow area, water polo markings, and therapy spa



FEATURES

- The Meyer Tennis Center features six courts, all of which have lights. Restrooms, drinking fountains, benches, and tables are located at the facility
- The grass soccer field is regulation size, lined, and well maintained. The field does not have lights. There is bleacher seating for 35 people and ample room for blankets and chairs
- The Trefethen Aquatic Center has a 25 yard outdoor pool with ten competition lanes, shallow area, and therapy spa.
- The gymnasium provides space for a shortened basketball court (3/4 court) or one or two volleyball courts. There is bleacher seating for 90 people and event seating (with reduced court space) for up to 200 people
- · Classroom with two chalkboards, one white board, a drop down projector screen, a six-foot table and chairs with attached desks
- The activity room has a Taraflex floor, mirrored walls, two windows, and fans. This space is ideal for low impact, movement events such as yoga, massage, and self-defense

Sports: Soccer, Ultimate Frisbee, Tennis, Volleyball, Badminton, Youth Basketball, Swimming, Water Polo, Fencing, Martial Arts, Yoga, Mind/Body, and Capoeira

ROAD WARRIORS

Oakland is blessed with waterfront amenities like no other. EAST BAY REGIONAL PARKS

The East Bay Regional Park District is a system of beautiful parklands and trails in Alameda and Contra Costa counties east of San Francisco. The system comprises 114,000+ acres in 65 parks, including over 1,200 miles of trails. The parks are ideal for healthful recreation. Parks include facilities for hiking, biking, horseback riding, fishing, archery, marksmanship, golfing, and boating.

CITY OF OAKLAND FACILITIES

The City of Oakland has many athletic fields, and tennis courts available to rent that accommodate various types of sports and activities. There are 52 multi-use fields, ranging from football to soccer and are available for group tournaments.

Where is Oakland?

Oakland, California is located on the eastern side of the San Francisco Bay. Oakland is only 12 minutes from San Francisco and 10 minutes from the UC Berkeley campus.




How Do I Get to Oakland?

Oakland International Airport is the second largest San Francisco Bay Area airport offering over 300 daily passenger flights. If you're traveling by car, driving to Oakland is a cinch, with multiple points of access along the I-880, I-580 and I-980. Oakland is serviced by Amtrak, connecting to cities such as Sacramento, Reno and Bakersfield, as well as daily routes to Seattle, Los Angeles and Chicago. Regionally, the Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) system offers service to and from the East Bay and San Francisco. A bustling port city, Oakland also offers transportation by the San Francisco Bay Ferry as well as guest slips for private boats along the estuary.

What's the Weather Like?

What makes Oakland unique?

Oakland boasts 19 miles of coastline, more than 100,00 acres of parks and trails, a redwood forest and a large urban lake. Oakland is also one of the most diverse cities in the country, with more than 125 different languages and dialects spoken and home to more artists per capita than any other city in California.



What else can we do in Oakland?

Attractions within the city limits include Jack London Square, Plank, Chabot Space & Science Center, Children's Fairyland, Oakland Aviation Museum, Oakland Museum of California, Oakland Zoo, and the USS Potomac. Lake Merritt, the "Jewel of Oakland," is an urban lake in the middle of the city, one of the largest of its kind (a mix of salt and freshwater). The city is also home to three renovated Art Deco-inspired theaters: The Fox Theater, The Paramount Theatre and the Grand Lake Theater. For information on things to see in Oakland, maps and brochures, stop by the Oakland Visitor Center between 9:30am – 4:00pm, Tuesday – Sunday.
