The Greater Oklahoma City Area Certified Tourism Ambassador program is pleased to announce Shane Granger as the recipient for the CTA Gold Star for 2015.

Birthered in July of 2012, the program partnered area tourism leaders to unite front-line tourism representatives not only to serve current visitors, but also to prepare for the future of Oklahoma City.
