Bag-size restrictions enforced during 2018 annual Shareholders Meeting

Omaha, Neb. (April 30, 2018) – Later this week, CenturyLink Center Omaha is thrilled to once again welcome thousands of people from across the world to the 2018 Berkshire Hathaway Annual Shareholders Meeting. Attendees are encouraged to arrive early, and familiarize themselves with the venue’s prohibited items and actions list before the big event.

Just like last year, CenturyLink Center Omaha will be enforcing bag-size restrictions. Bags and backpacks must be 19 inches tall, by 14 inches long and 12 inches wide or **smaller**. Please see the attached graphic for clarification. Be advised, this is not a clear bag event, but walk-through metal detectors will be in use. The bag-size restrictions will be in place both Friday, May 4th for “Shopping Day”, and Saturday, May 5th for the meeting.

Any person who arrives with a bag larger than these guidelines (including luggage) will have the option to “check” their bags at box-truck provided by Clark Security at the north, exterior end of the building. This service will **only** be provided during Saturday’s meeting – and will **not** be available on Friday, May

LARGER BAGS MUST BE CHECKED

To ensure a safe environment for all guests, shareholders may be asked to display the contents of clothing, purses, etc. The below prohibited items will be strictly enforced.

PROHIBITED - ITEMS & ACTIONS

- No professional cameras (4" or greater) ****Cameras are not allowed during the movie. Cameras are only allowed on the arena concourse and in the Exhibit Hall / Meeting Room Level during the movie and meeting.***
- No video recording
- No audio recording
- No laser pointers
- No outside food or drink (20 oz. or smaller empty clear plastic bottles will be allowed for water)
- No bags or backpacks larger than 19" by 14"
- No umbrellas
- Noise making devices of any kind (i.e. bells, whistles, horns, etc.)
- No beach balls
- No Go Pro cameras
- No fireworks
- No illegal drugs and alcohol
- No cutting devices
- No weapons of any kind including lawfully concealed firearms
- No chains or spikes
- No tablets or selfie-sticks
- No signs or banners
- Masks are prohibited and may not be worn at any time while inside the arena
- Drones are not permitted on MECA's campus
