- 2017 tourist spending increased by 3.1% over 2016



Visitors to McCracken County:

- Generated \$105,504 in combined state & local tax revenues
- Created **\$13,572** in local tax revenues
- Created **\$91,932** in state tax revenues

2017 Tourism Tax Relief on Households

As a result of taxes generated by tourist spending in McCracken County...

In 2017, each of the **27,514** McCracken County households paid **\$1,400 less** in local and state taxes. In other words, if tourism did not exist, each household would have paid **\$1,400 more** in state and local taxes in 2017 to replace the taxes generated by tourist spending.
