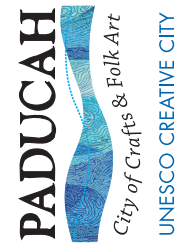

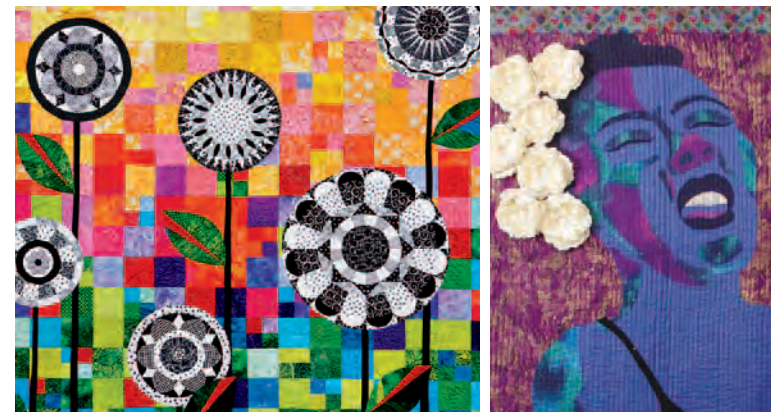

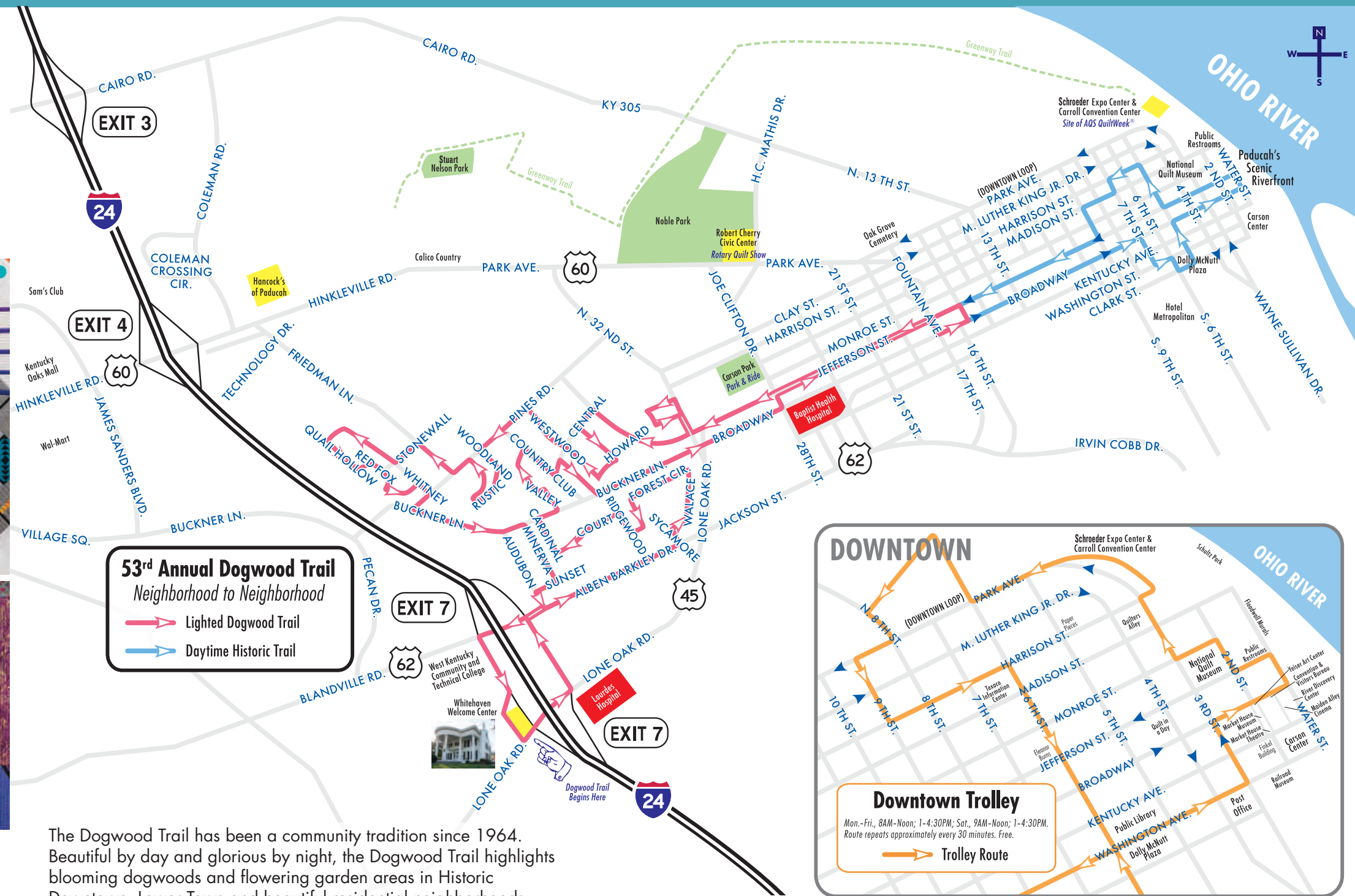

## Things You Need to Know

### Getting Around Town

Free shuttle service is provided by participating hotels, attractions, Paducah Visitors Bureau, AQS and Anchor Tours. Shuttle routes and authorized stops are published in the AQS Show Book. Free Downtown and Lower Town trolley rides provide access to The National Quilt Museum, AQS Vendors on Kentucky and the AQS Bus Stop.

### Carson Center Shuttle

Buses begin route from the AQS Bus Stop (next to the Carroll Convention Center) to the Carson Center 45 minutes prior to the start of each event and return to the AQS Bus Stop at the conclusion of the event.

### Parking

- Schroeder Expo Center lot (enter at the stoplight at Executive Blvd. and 4th Street)
- City lot, Jefferson St. and 2nd St. (in front of the floodwall)
- Park and Ride: Park at Carson Park (Joe Clifton Dr./28th St. & Madison St.) and ride the Express Shuttle Bus to and from the AQS Bus Stop and Carson Park.

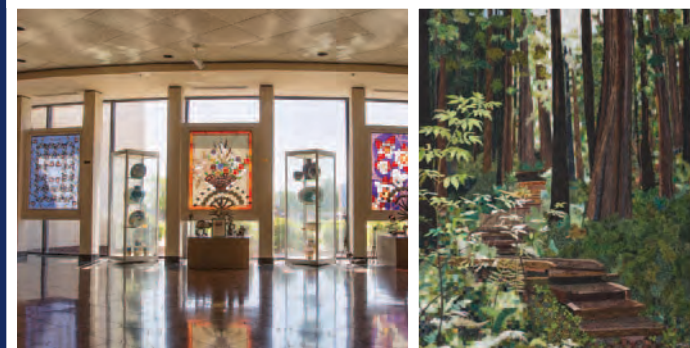

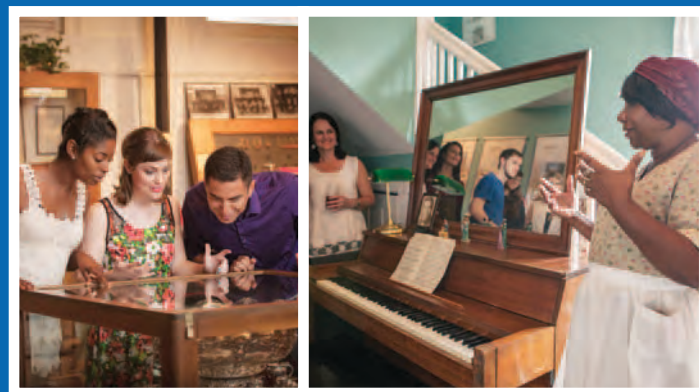

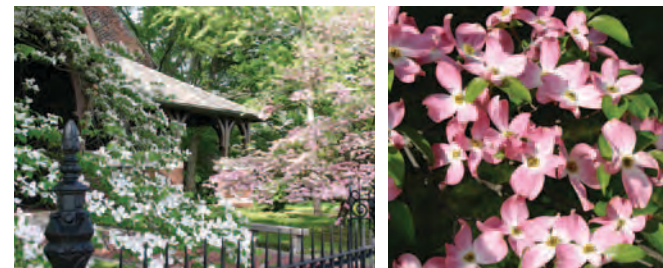
