NEW ORDINANCES

- All alcohol sales end at 2AM throughout the month of March.
- Metal shovels are not permitted on the beach, and any holes dug in the sand should not be deeper than 2 feet.
- Drinking alcoholic beverages on the sandy beach is prohibited during the month of March.
- Possession and consumption of alcohol is prohibited in the commercial parking lots.
- Parking in a closed business's parking lot is prohibited
- Overnight scooter rental is not permitted.
- It is illegal to climb, jump from or throw things from balconies.
- Parking is prohibited on unmarked or unpaved portions of the road after dark.

SAFETY TIPS

- Travel in a group with friends, and avoid people/situations that make you nervous.
- Feel comfortable approaching sand patrol officers.
- Drink LOTS of water while in the sun.
- Drink responsibly when consuming alcohol (21 years and older).
