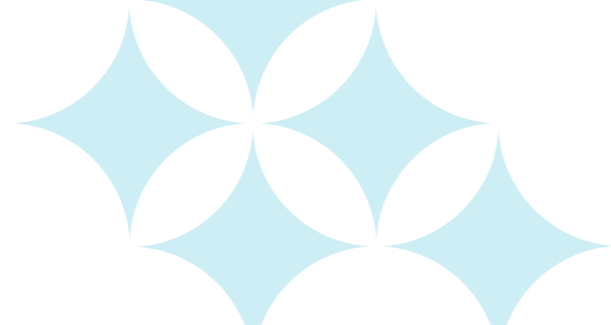

| Shopping in the city from high-end fashion boutiques and homogenous shopping centre stores to indigenous art sellers, homemade craft stalls and plenty of gourmand markets. Then head to the Wesley Quarter for a bit of glamour and Northbridge for chic local design. Key areas: Hay Street and Murray Street pedestrian-only malls ably replicate the best high street shopping, while King Street has designer boutiques and galleries selling Aboriginal art. | 3 hrs | Free |

Discover the vibrant dining and small bar scene, take a walking tour to admire street art-filled laneways or spend time in the sun at Elizabeth Quay; the new landmark waterfront development reconnecting Perth city with the Swan River to create a dynamic new entertainment and leisure precinct.

The port city of Fremantle is famed for its rich cultural heritage, lively entertainment spots, maritime & penal history and alternative, alfresco lifestyle. Over 150 buildings in the port city have been heritage listed by the National Trust, recognising Freo as the best preserved 19th century seaport in the world.

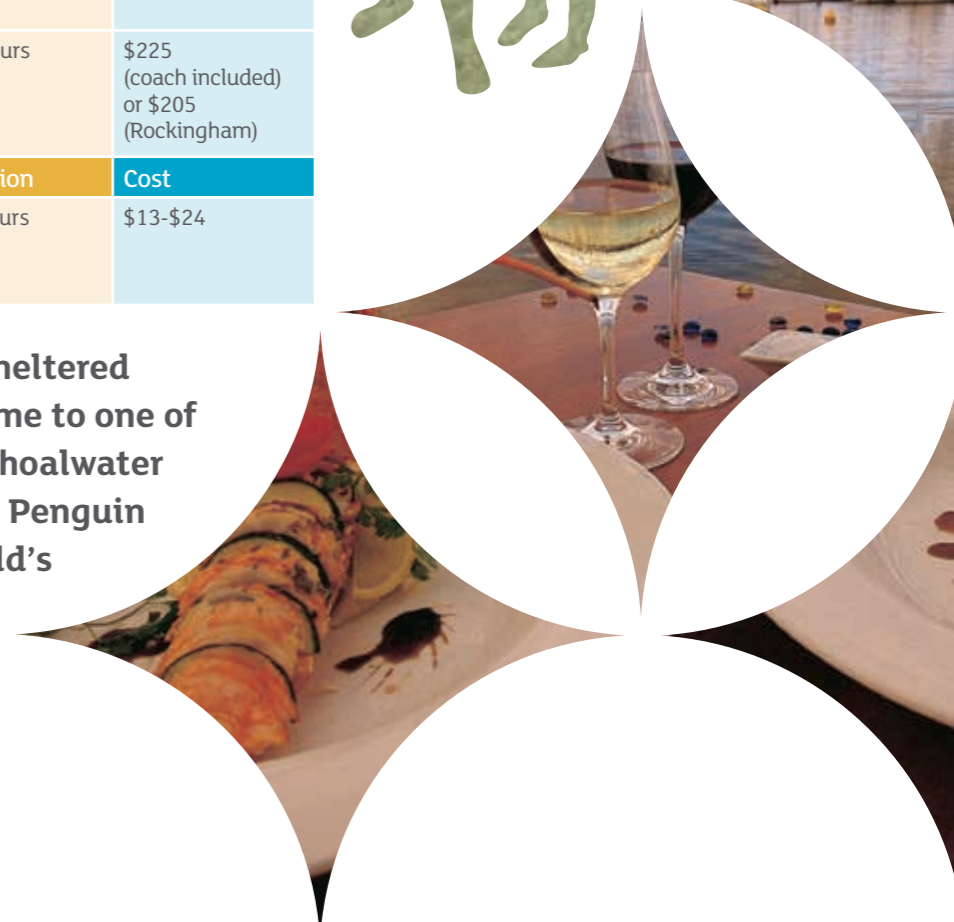
