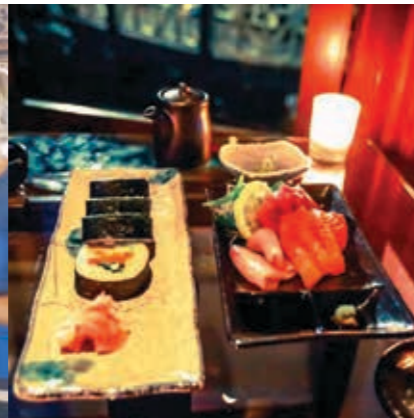
Introduction to Regional WA

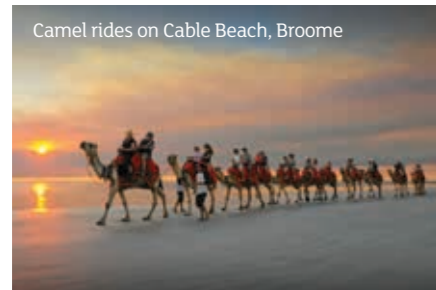

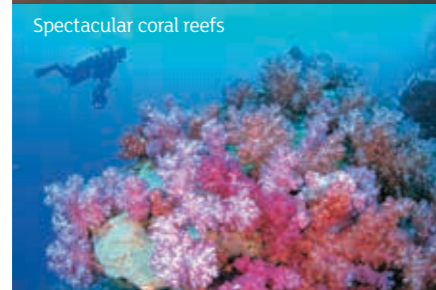

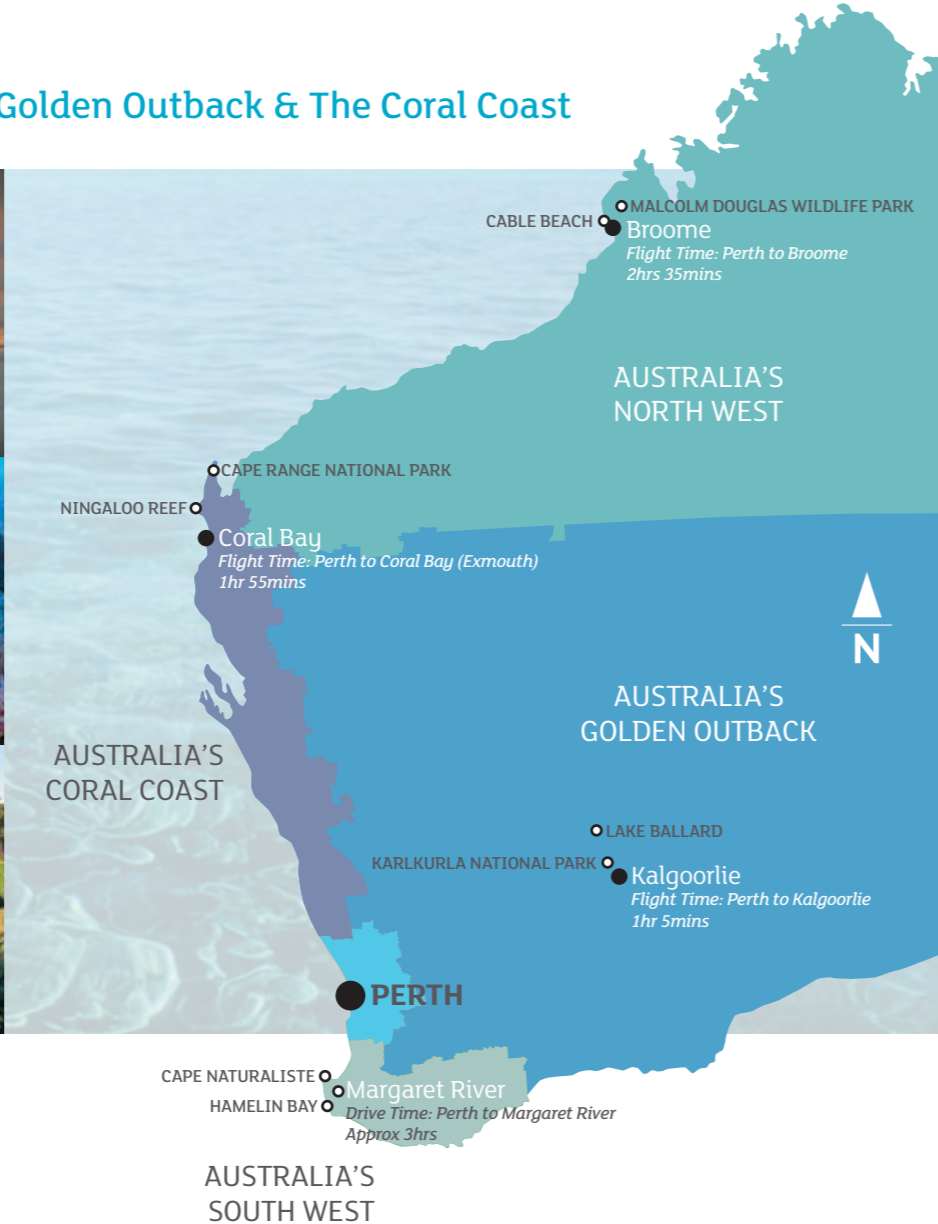

With over 35000 whales migrating close to the shores of Geographe Bay (between June and November) jump on board with Geographe Marine Charters and enjoy a bucket list experience - close up with the whales.	3hrs	\$90

Indulge in a relaxing afternoon spa treatment at Pullman Bunker Bay Resort's Vie Spa.	1-2hrs	\$85-250
Head into Margaret River town and dine at one of the many cafes, pubs or restaurants located on the main strip.	2hrs	\$20-80

Golden Outback: 2 Days

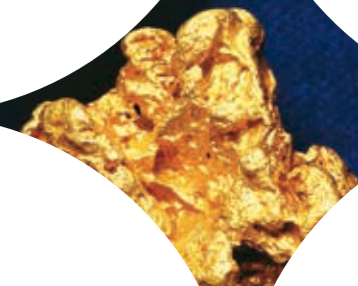
DAY 1: Morning Activity	Duration	Cost
Breakfast at Karlkurla Park for Indigenous cultural experience.	1.5 hrs	\$50
Full Day Tour with Goldrush Tours This tour is a great introduction to the city of Kalgoorlie-Boulder, exploring architecture of the 1890's. Visit the Superpit, one of the largest open pit gold mining operations in the world. Tour also includes Hannans North Tourist Mine where you can climb aboard a 793C dump truck and try your hand at gold panning as well as many other attractions.	5 hrs	\$90
Scenic Flight with Goldfields Air Services - a scenic flight which offers the best view over the Super Pit and the stunning desert landscape.	1 hr	\$100

DAY 2: Morning Activity	Duration	Cost
Take a full day tour to Lake Ballard with Big Sky Red Earth Tours. The now famous Sir Antony Gormley sculptures at Lake Ballard represent over 50 of the residents of the town of Menzies. These carbonised steel figures are stretched across the white salt lake, take plenty of water with you and walk to view some or all of the figures. Then enjoy billy tea and bush camp oven damper with jam prepared by your Big Sky Red Earth Tours host. On the way back, call into an Outback Bush Pub, such as Ora Banda or Broad Arrow.	8 hrs	\$130
DAY 2: Afternoon Activity	Duration	Cost
Have dinner on Hannan's Street at The Palace Hotel Balcony Restaurant In the late 1890's, Kalgoorlie's streets were a flurry of construction and development as the wealth generated in the gold mines was flaunted in grand and impressive architecture. The Palace Hotel, built in 1897, and designed to be the most luxurious hotel outside of Perth, stood tall amongst them and continues to be a landmark building in Kalgoorlie. One of the Palace Hotel's regular guests in its early days was Herbert Hoover, who as a 22 year old US mining engineer worked in the Goldfields for several years. During this time he reportedly fell in love with a barmaid at the hotel before leaving to marry his college sweetheart and continue his mining career in China, before rising to take the American Presidency in 1929. The elaborately carved mirror which stands in the foyer of the hotel was his parting gift to the Hotel where he spent much of his time when he was in Kalgoorlie.	2 hrs	\$60



The Golden Outback is a vast and diverse region, spanning across 54% of Western Australia.

It stretches from the rugged red earth in the north, to the snow-white beaches in the south. Central to the Golden Outback is the mining hub of Kalgoorlie and the Goldfields.



Itineraries:

Coral Coast: 2 Days

DAY 1: Morning Activity	Duration	Cost
Take an early morning flight to Learmonth, transferring or self-driving to Coral Bay. A snorkelers paradise, Coral Bay boasts calm, protected waters and hundreds of fish and coral species. Here, the reef spans two kilometres from the shore - an endless source of marine life. To explore further out, take a glass-bottom boat trip or join a snorkelling tour. Spend the evening watching the sunset and dining at one of Coral Bay's great restaurants.		
Quad-Treks ATV Adventures with Coral Bay Tours, Turtle Adventure Trek and Snorkel.	2.5 hrs	\$230
Light lunch at Ningaloo Reef Café.	1 hr	\$20
DAY 1: Afternoon Activity	Duration	Cost
Spend the afternoon enjoying the beach and water before finishing the day with a Sunset Tour.		
Board a glass bottom boat, Nhanya-Ku, with Coral Bay Ecotours for a 2 hour sunset cruise. Enjoy nibbles and a relaxing drink in a beautiful, protected bay. Cruising across amazing coral formations and watching a spectacular sunset over the Ningaloo Reef.	2 hrs	\$65

DAY 2: Morning Activity	Duration	Cost
Ningaloo Safari Tours Yardie Creek Safari – Cape Range National Park.		
	8 hrs	\$170
Cape Range National Park Travel through the Cape Range National Park to see native wildlife, including red kangaroos, euros, emus, bungarras and bustards. Learn about the area and take the opportunity to purchase gifts at DPaWs Milyering Discovery Centre. Enjoy a picnic hamper lunch under the shade of the Tamerisk trees before boarding the Ningaloo Safari Tours boat to cruise up Yardie Creek. See local wildlife including the giant Osprey nests and the timid black footed rock wallabies sunning themselves on the rocks. On to Turquoise Bay the perfect environment to snorkel and swim on the Ningaloo Reef.		
Afternoon tea before heading to the Vlamingh Head Lighthouse. Great photo opportunity from the panoramic vantage point of Lighthouse Hill.		
Overnight: Mantarays Ningaloo Beach Resort.		

The Coral Coast stretches along 1,100km of pristine coastline and is surrounded by vibrant wildflowers, wildlife and coral reefs teeming with exotic marine life. The World Heritage listed Ningaloo Reef is the world's largest fringing reef and one of the few places on the planet where you can swim with Whale Sharks.
