



**Marine Safety Information Bulletin (MSIB) 17-016, Hurricane Irma**

Weather Advisory

Return to Normal Port Conditions

Time: 12:00 p.m. / Date: Tuesday, September 12, 2017

The Captain of the Port (COTP) has determined that Port Everglades is safe for marine traffic and is **downgrading their Port Conditions and returning to seasonal watch preparedness in accordance with MSIB 17-009.**

**Prohibited Operations:** Night time

**Authorized Operations:** North-port, mid-port, and turning basin of Port Everglades are open to day light transits only.

**Anticipated Future Actions:** Port Everglades may return to normal operations and seasonal watch preparedness in accordance with MSIB 17-009 this afternoon.

**This MSIB applies to Port Everglades only. All other ports will maintain Port Condition Zulu until modified by the Captain of the Port via subsequent MSIBs.**
