

Southport Turning Notch Extension

Port Everglades is berth constrained and additional dock space is needed, especially for cargo ships as the Port has become Florida's leader for containerized cargo volumes. The Southport Turning Notch Extension project will lengthen the existing deepwater turn-around area for cargo ships from approximately 900 feet to 2,400 feet, which will allow for up to five new cargo berths. Super Post-Panamax gantry cranes, will also be added to serve the existing Southport container berths, and the crane rails will be extended to the full length of the existing Turning Notch berth to utilize the existing cranes.

Project Description

The Port Everglades Southport Turning Notch Extension (STNE) project will lengthen the existing STNE from approximately 900 feet to 2,400 feet at the existing depth of 42 feet. This project will provide for up to five additional berths. A critical part of the Southport Turning Notch Extension includes replacing 8.7 acres of an existing mangrove conservation easement with a 16.5-acre upland enhancement of approximately 70,000 new mangroves and wetland plants, a project element that is now completed, as well as completing a number of environmental improvements in West Lake Park. Port officials worked closely with port users, the environmental community, and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to develop the plan for the new mangrove habitat.

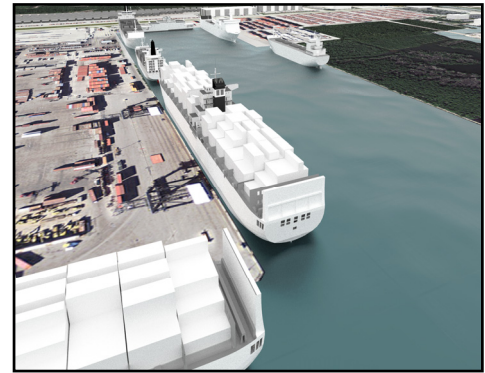

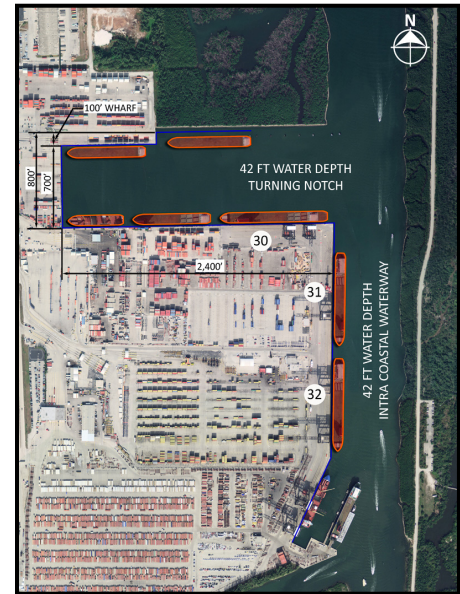
