

# Forest City, North Carolina

Every year, thousands of people from near and far come to celebrate the Christmas season in Forest City, where more than one million lights shine brightly from Thanksgiving night through mid-January.

Each evening brings hundreds of cars streaming through a canopy of red, green, and clear lights. The live oaks lining Main Street are wrapped in tiny clear lights and standing displays of reindeer, snowmen, and toy soldiers inhabit the landscaped median around the town fountain.

On Thanksgiving night at 6:00pm, the Town hosts the annual tree lighting ceremony. After a brief welcome from the Town Manager, a choir sings a medley of well-loved Christmas tunes. Partnering with the Town, Facebook's Forest City Data Center awards the Facebook Community Action Grants during the ceremony. Afterward, the Mayor and his special guest flip the switch to turn on the lights! Everyone joins the choir in singing We Wish You a Merry Christmas as the crowd walks down Main Street to Santa's House (pictured on right) for complimentary hot chocolate and cookies! As Santa awaits visitors outside his house, he keeps a close eye on the iceskating rink located next door.

The following Sunday, Main Street is filled with happy and excited folks, young and old, as the Forest City Merchants oversee the **annual Christmas parade!** Starting at McNair Stadium, the parade travels East on Main Street and ends at Forest City Methodist Church.

On Friday nights, park your car and **catch** a **ride on the hay wagon** as it makes it way down Main Street! Grab a pair of **magical eyeglasses** and watch the lights change into snowmen, reindeer and ornaments!


