## Salt Lake County Fair Highlights 3rd Quarter Events

The annual **Salt Lake County Fair** was the largest event of the quarter at the Equestrian Park. During its four-day run, August 12 – 15, the Fair featured some new events and many of the expected favorites. The opening night Grandstand concert with Joe Nichols was very well attended, as was the Monster Truck Show/Motor Cross. Other special events included the Knights of Mayhem jousting troupe, a luau and a rodeo. The carnival was relocated to the east parking lot area and showed nearly a 50% increase in revenue over the previous year. The Fair also featured several food trucks at the main entrance to complement the many traditional Fair food vendors. 4-H animal barns, a petting zoo, crafts and mainstage entertainment were also featured. Prior to the Fair, the facility hosted in July the following events: **Utah All Breed Horse Association, Barrel Buddies Club Night, Los Reyes Promotions, Utah's Mounted Thunder, Wasatch Horse Show Association, Jr. Livestock** and the **Rocky Mountain Waterfowl Festival**.

Following the Fair, there were two non-equestrian events, **the Utah Pheasant Society** and the **Great Basin Fiber Arts Fair**. Equestrian events included: **the Utah Paint Horse Club, Utah Quarter Horse Association Auction, Los Tigres Promotions, Wasatch Horse Show Association** and a **4-H Livestock Meeting**.

## Equestrian Park Beefs up Security

Cameras have been installed throughout the Event Center to increase safety and security. The barn areas are still in need of added surveillance to ensure that Park policies are not being violated. The gates on the 2200 West side of the Park are now being locked to prevent after-hours access. Part-time Security patrols now work on the weekends.

## Staff Continues Monthly Safety Training Sessions

Recent training sessions have included basic First Aid, inclement weather protocols, hand protection, safety behaviors and documentation team training.



On July 8th, staff conducted an Emergency Response Plan training and then held an emergency evacuation drill on July 29th.

## Footing Project Underway in Arenas

After Operations Manager Mike Terry attended the Footing Academy in Oklahoma last quarter and had the Equestrian Park Arena footing (dirt) analyzed by an industry specialist, Operations will gradually add 165 tons of special sand mix in Arena 5 to break down the clay and give it a more consistent pan. This remedy also makes the footing a little softer, improving traction. This addition of sand will be completed incrementally so as not to create a rolling surface. Arena 1 will be next on the list for improvement. These two arenas were chosen first because they are used the most and are specifically used for barrel racing — an event where footing is very critical.

## Barn Improvement Project Underway

The indoor barns at the Park are nearly 70 years' old and in need of repair. Barn A will be the first in the series of improvements that will be made by the Operations Department. The project will include repairing and replacing stall doors; leveling stall grounds and aisles; and, cleaning and repairing other items that are discovered during the project. A fabrication program is being set up on

site in order to repair barn doors that have been damaged by rust. This will be an ongoing process as each stall will be evaluated and needs will be inventoried.
