spent first quarter prepping the outdoor arenas and racetrack. This is always a challenge because the ground is wet and must dry out in between multiple grading sessions. The racetrack alone took about six weeks to fully prep after the Chariot racing season.

500 & 600 Barns

Work continues on repairing and upgrading these barns with a projected completion by the end of April. In addition to the repair work, the barns will receive a new coat of paint.

General Upkeep

Crews have begun their weed mitigation program throughout the park. Storm drains were hydro-blasted and gutters on all the structures were cleaned.

2015 Paint Show at Park Takes Top Honors

The American Paint Horse Association, along with the *Paint Horse Journal*, has recognized the Western Regional Zone 2
Zone Show as the number one show of the year. It took place at the Equestrian Park last May and was sponsored by the Utah Paint Horse Club. This is the seventh time in nine years that this show has received the top ranking. The show attracted over 1,000 entries.

Partnership between Sheriff's Office and Equestrian Park is a Win-Win Situation

Last October, SMG initiated a partnership with the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Department to revive the Jail Crew Work Program at the Equestrian Park. Marty Oviatt, who was part of the Park's Operations Department, became Supervisor of the program. Monday through Thursday, Marty heads to the Salt Lake County jail and picks up low-risk, non-violent offenders who are assigned to work at the Park instead of spending time in jail. The participants, in fact, spend no time in jail unless they violate the terms of program, which includes being drug tested before heading to the Park. A crew of between two and five people work from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., cleaning out the show barns, pulling weeds or cleaning.



Marty Oviatt Named Employee of the Quarter

Marty Oviatt is the recipient

of first quarter honors, selected by his peers who serve on the Employee Action Committee. Marty started working for SMG in 2014, after working several years for Salt Lake County. He continues to work for both the Equestrian Park and Salt Lake County on a part-time basis. In his County role, he Supervises the Jail Crew Work Force. At the Park, he is part of the Operations Department. Marty spent 40 years in service to our country as a member of the US Army.
