

Water Features Policy

All exhibit items that contain and/or hold water, including hot tubs, pools, ponds, fountains, etc., must feature a method and/or means of containing any water should it leak or overflow. Exhibitors will be responsible for the installation and removal of protective materials. The Mountain America Expo Center Events Department must be provided plans reflecting the location(s), size, construction materials and other necessary specifications, as well as the estimated water content of each water feature, prior to load-in. No water feature will be allowed at the Mountain America Expo Center without prior approval from Mountain America Expo Center management.

Procedures:

- The floor must be swept prior to placement of any water feature to help prevent puncture leaks.
- The facility floor must be covered with a minimum 6 millimeter leak-free material prior to installation of any water containment feature. This floor cover must have a ridge around the perimeter high enough to contain minor leaks before spilling onto the floor.
- Pools must have rigid sides and must be manufactured for water retention with a minimum 16 millimeter thickness and constructed by trained personnel.
- A written plan must be provided to the Mountain America Expo Center management reflecting action to be taken should a leak or structural failure occur.
- The Exhibitor and/or Show management is responsible for providing the equipment needed to rapidly drain their water feature should a leak occur.
- After hours contact phone numbers for the exhibitor and Show management must be provided to Mountain America Expo Center management.
- Filling and draining will be completed by the Mountain America Expo Center Engineering Department.
- All leaks must be reported to Mountain America Expo Center management immediately upon discovery.
- Any water feature that has experienced three or more leaks must be drained and use discontinued. A revised plan must be submitted to Mountain America Expo Center management for approval before a water feature can be refilled.
- All and any expense for draining and filling of any water feature is the responsibility of the Exhibitor or Show Management.

Water features requiring electricity must be hooked up by one of four facility-approved electrical contractors. Electrical must use a distribution panel that is equipped with the appropriate power need and GFI protection. See your Event Manager for a list of approved electrical contractors.

Calculate the rate of water fills and drains:

Advanced rate 0-99 gallons	\$80/per each device
Onsite rate 0-99 gallons	\$90/per each device
Advanced rate 100-500 gallons	\$160/per each device
Onsite rate 100-500 gallons	\$190/per each device
