'Turkey Point' has approximately 65 km of well-maintained and signed singletrack trails both within and adjacent to Turkey Point Provincial Park and St. Williams Conservation Reserve. Both Burning Kiln Winery and Long Point Eco-Adventures (LPEA) feature trails on and through their sites. Beginners have plenty of terrain to explore; while more experienced riders will be thrilled with the technical and speedy riding.

Hours of Operation: Open year round, in most weather conditions.

Fees: Club memberships \$35/year.

Onsite conveniences: Long Point: bike wash, washrooms, drinking water • Turkey Point: washrooms, drinking water, laundry, park store and picnic tables/BBQ stations.
