A LANDMARK PLACE

One of the most important legal rulings in our nation's history is rooted in Topeka. The 1954 U.S. Supreme Court decision in Brown vs. Board of Education declared "separate but equal" unconstitutional and ended segregation of public schools, spurring national desegregation. Explore the historic Monroe School on your own or on a free ranger-led tour, departing at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m., or by request. A junior ranger program is available. A visitor favorite is the hands-on experience in the kindergarten classroom. It features books, chalk and a piano.
