THE CROWN JEWEL OF KANSAS

The Kansas State Capitol is a must-see for all Topeka visitors. The statehouse is rich with Kansas history; restored features, include painted stenciling on the walls and copper on the roof and dome. While there, ride to the fifth floor in an antique, operator-run elevator. Then catch a breathtaking view from the exterior of the dome after climbing 296 stairs to reach the top. The Kansas statehouse is the only capitol building in the U.S. where the public can walk along the exterior balcony. Both historic and dome tours are led by knowledgeable guides from the Kansas Historical Society and are free to the public at scheduled times.
