

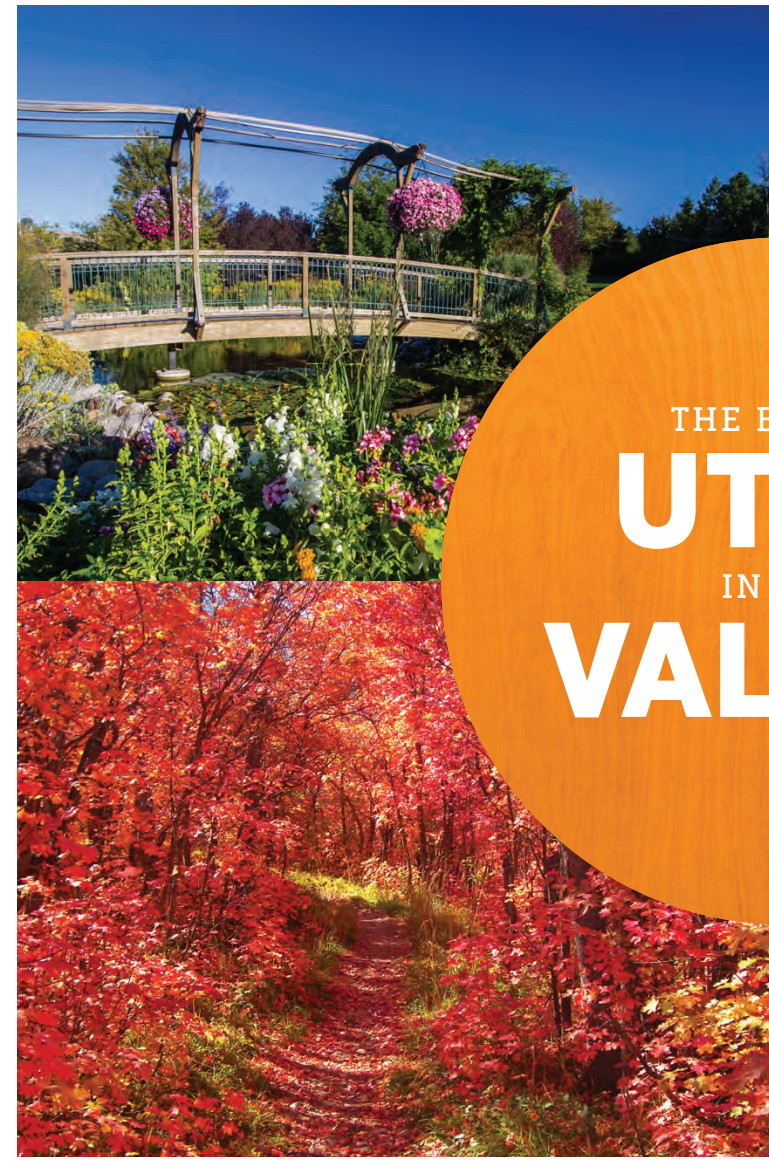

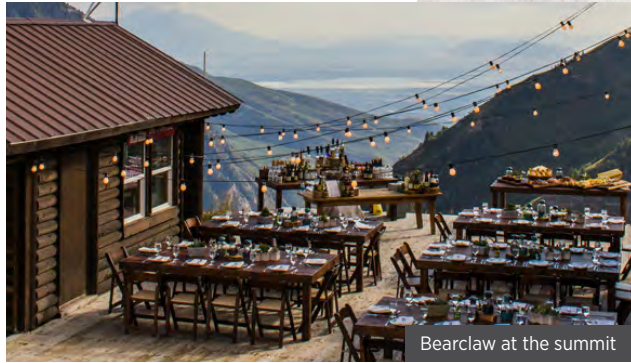

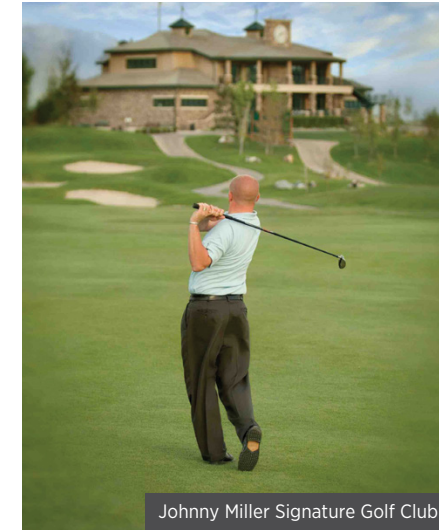

Ashton Gardens features 15 themed gardens spread over 55 acres, including the largest man-made waterfall in the Western Hemisphere.

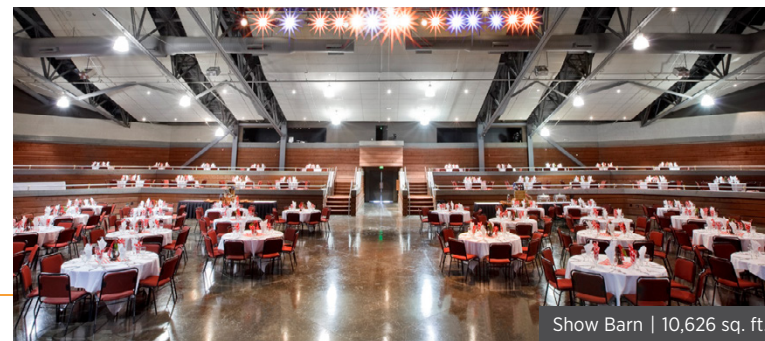
