




Thanksgiving Point
















Mountain Recreation

Utah Valley is located in north central Utah, bordered on the east by the Wasatch Mountains and on the west by Utah Lake.

How To Get Here


An easy drive from anywhere in the Intermountain West and easily accessible from two Utah airports, getting to your event is simple. Reach Utah Valley through any of these transportation options:

- SALT LAKE CITY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SLC): SLC is a major hub for Delta Air Lines with about 70% of total traffic from Delta. There are approximately 330 scheduled, commercial departures from SLC each day, serving approximately 90 cities with non-stop flights.
- **PROVO REGIONAL AIRPORT (PVU):** Offering flights from Los Angeles (LAX), Oakland (OAK), San Diego (SAN), and Mesa (AZA)
- UTA FRONTRUNNER & TRAX: High-speed train and public transit railway
- I-15: Utah's main interstate runs right to and through Utah Valley, and intersects with I-80 just north of Utah Valley.
