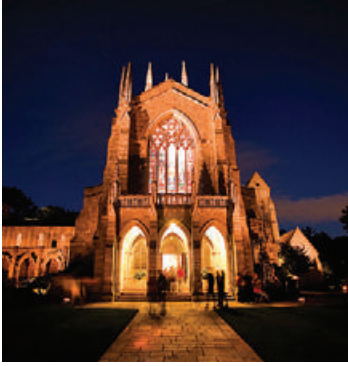

EXPLORE

Discover the national treasures of Montgomery County. Take in the past and present with illuminating tours of our historic sites, mansions and museums, in addition to art collections, performing arts and more.

REVOLUTIONARY HISTORY

You can access the 3,500-acre **Valley Forge National Historical Park** through numerous touring options: themed trolley, bicycle, car and even on foot. Visit the original stone headquarters that General Washington used to plot strategy and hone tactics, and see where the Continental Army drilled and lived.

While at the park, stop at the **Visitor Center**, featuring hands-on exhibits, and **The Encampment Store**, stocked with Valley Forge souvenirs. Access to the park is free.

Youngsters can “Join the Continental Army,” dressing in Colonial uniforms and marching in formation during the first Saturday of each month from January through April. The whole family can relive Army life in the late 1700s, courtesy of reenactors who raise authenticity to an art form.

It’s easier than ever to see the Park’s highlights. An old-fashioned trolley offers 90-minute tours. You can also enjoy a tour with a private guide, summer/fall bicycle tours, on foot with an accompanying ranger or a self-paced, 10-mile **Encampment Tour Route** in your own car, with an audio track providing details.

Patriot Trails is the newest way to encounter the sites of the Revolutionary War throughout Montgomery County, PA. The itineraries for these self-driven tours are web-based and all begin in Valley Forge National Historical Park, sending history buffs to destinations that played a significant role in the nation’s quest for freedom.

MANORS AND MANSIONS

Valley Forge National Historical Park is the gateway to many other notable sites, including **Pottsgrove Manor** in Pottstown—the 1752 Georgian mansion of Pottstown founder and Colonial ironmaster, John Potts. Tour it to see how Potts, his family, servants and slaves lived and worked in the 18th century. Then, discover **Pennypacker Mills** in nearby Schwenksville. The Colonial Revival country estate provides a beautiful example of early Pennsylvania history with tours. Don’t miss the annual Civil War “Reunion” with reenactors and historians.

See where General Washington planned the 1777 Battle of Germantown—at **Peter Wentz Farmstead** in Worcester. A 90-acre working farm, complete with 18th century German kitchen, garden and farm animals, surrounds this restored Colonial stone home.

Discover **Morgan Log House**, a meticulously restored example of early domestic architecture located in Towamencin Township. The land was originally owned by Daniel Boone's grandfather, Edward Morgan.

Montgomery County's military history goes well beyond the 18th century. Explore the **Wings of Freedom Aviation Museum**, where veterans often gather among their donated artifacts to speak first-hand of World War II, Korea, Vietnam and Afghanistan. Our tradition of honoring heroes extends to present day at the **Medal of Honor Grove** at the **Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge**. A 52-acre walk contains obelisks dedicated to every Congressional Medal of Honor recipient, state by state.

ART & CULTURE

Given its multifaceted cultural influences, Montgomery County is a place of deep inspiration. It's no wonder that artists, musicians and dramatists tap this tradition to craft lasting works of beauty.

Wharton Esherick left a legacy of stunning woodworking and furniture in his Paoli home-studio, a National Historic Landmark for Architecture. Bring home a whimsical souvenir wooden martini mixer or notecards from his original woodcuts. Guided tours by reservation only.

The Knoll Museum, located in East Greenville, houses an unparalleled collection of iconic and no-longer-produced Knoll furniture designs. The museum illustrates 75 years of evolving tastes, technical and material innovations and changing consumer needs. Visit the museum and see why Knoll is the first name in furniture design.

Beth Sholom Synagogue is one of Frank Lloyd Wright's most important buildings and the only synagogue designed by this great American architect. A soaring glass roof—repeating geometric motifs in brilliant colors and textures—makes this a most memorable house of worship.

Bryn Athyn was founded as a religious community in the late 1800s. Now designated a historic district, its monumental buildings are magnificent and timeless. Visit the **Bryn Athyn Cathedral**, a combination of Romanesque and Gothic styles, and see stained glass meticulously made using the medieval method.

Next, tour the Beaux Arts **Cairwood Estate**, a luxe example of an industrialist's Gilded Age country estate. The nearby **Glencairn Museum** showcases religious art and history from Ancient Egyptian to Native American—the collection of medieval stained glass and sculpture is one of the nation's best.

Montgomery County's Pennsylvania Dutch and German traditions are on full display in the artifacts, displays and programming of the **Mennonite Heritage Center** and the **Schwenkenfelder Library**, both reflecting the area's deep roots in faith.

Are old cars and wagons art? Answer for yourself at the **Boyetown Museum of Historic Vehicles**. The collection includes motorized, horse-drawn and man-powered transportation—from wagons and trucks to bicycles and cars. Many manufacturers' names may be unfamiliar, but all were made or designed right here in Pennsylvania.

With so much to see, art lovers can feel at home in Montgomery County. **Abington Art Center** presents exhibitions, programs and events designed to make the visual arts a part of your world.

Cheltenham Center for the Arts offers classes, exhibitions and theater programs that promote regional artists and showcase the work of children, adults and outstanding faculty in our community.

The **John James Audubon Center at Mill Grove** was the first American home of renowned artist, author and naturalist John James Audubon. Today it serves as an educational center of the National Audubon Society, dedicated to connecting people with nature.

PERFORMING ARTS

If you love live theater, take a seat on the aisle at Ambler's **Act II Playhouse** for award-winning new, classical and contemporary plays and musicals. Summer visitors can check out "Summer Fling," a three-week festival of comedy, music and dance.

The company at **DCP Theater** stages it all: comedy, farce, musical, children's theater, drama, classics and a few gems from new playwrights. The blend of professional, semi-pro and community-based casts means that an evening of first-rate fun won't break the bank.

Or try Glenside's **Keswick Theatre**. This former vaudeville house is the place to go for everything from Irish singers to Peking Acrobats, to bands both large and small, performing hard rock to soft jazz. Previous performances include The Temptations and The Four Tops, Demetri Martin, Nas, Edgar Winter, Lyle Lovett, The B-52s and The Zombies.

In King of Prussia, the **Valley Forge Casino Resort Music Fair** brings headliner entertainment to the area. Performers are among the likes of Smokey Robinson, KC and the Sunshine Band and comedian Dave Attell.

Catch a show at **The Ardmore Music Hall**, which has established itself as a premiere venue for a host of renowned musical acts, both local and on tour.

POP CULTURE PARADISE

The 90-minute tram ride that takes visitors through the **American Treasure Tour** is a virtual time machine across more than 100 years of entertainment icons. This private collection covers three acres with thousands of items, ranging from massive musical instruments that once accompanied dancehalls and carnivals to automated figurines that graced department store displays.

Those who love to laugh at the antics of the Three Stooges must visit **The Stoogeum** (rhymes with “museum”), a trove of memorabilia from Moe, Larry, Curly, Shemp, Joe and Curly Joe. Relive the hilarity and learn something new about your favorite comedy trio.

LEARN SOMETHING NEW

Consider getting some friends together for a “Culinary Enthusiasts” course at **Montgomery County Community College’s Culinary Arts Institute**. The expert instructors will put a fresh spin on your kitchen style. Need new tools to fit your new skills? Check out **Sur La Table** or **Williams-Sonoma** at King of Prussia Mall.

Steve’s Sewing, Vacuum & Quilting in King of Prussia offers classes in needle arts—and culinary ones. The store has been outfitted with a state-of-the-art demo kitchen, where visitors can learn and practice cooking techniques.

ENJOY

Set your adventurous spirit free. From ziplining to mountain biking, snowboarding to hiking, a trip to the zoo or a round of heart-pounding laser tag, get ready to have a blast.





Spring Mountain Adventures

YOUR MONTGOMERY COUNTY ADVENTURE

Soar through the canopy at **Spring Mountain Adventures**, thanks to a zipline that carries you 40 feet off the ground. Bring your pint-sized adventurers too; there is a course especially designed for them, which accommodates children as young as six.

Or, you can capture the rush of flight on a mountain bike, speeding down a twisting passage from a 535-foot mountaintop at **Launch Bike Park**, also at Spring Mountain. Come winter, skiing, snowboarding and tubing on the slopes are the perfect ways to enjoy the snow.

SPEND TIME ON THE WATER

Paddle the **Perkiomen Creek** and enjoy a pristine day on the water; you will soon notice a wide variety of wildlife and a new level of calm. If you have your own transport, the **Perkiomen Trail** and **Schuylkill River Trail** offer plenty of put-in points for canoes, kayaks and boats.

Or, go deeper into Montgomery County and experience **Green Lane Park**. There are three bodies of water within the park's expansive footprint. During the idyllics of spring and summer, water lovers can be seen drifting over the glassy surface on paddleboards and canoes. Explorers who prefer to leave the propulsion to someone else can take a pontoon boat tour and enjoy an abundance of wildlife.

Wintertime on the water brings a photogenic serenity in addition to cold-weather sports. When conditions allow, skating is common, and ice-fishing is permitted.

FAMILY FUN

Much of the Valley Forge story is about overcoming personal challenges, a theme that resonates with runners of the annual **Valley Forge Revolutionary 5-Mile Run**®. Held each April, and celebrating its 10th anniversary in 2015, this USA Track & Field–certified event draws amateur and professional runners from up and down the East Coast. Kids can opt for a shorter run of a patriotic 1.776 kilometers (about one mile). Learn more at revolutionaryrun.org.

Not far from Valley Forge, the **Elmwood Park Zoo** is a great experience for the whole family. Kids can hand-feed giraffes and bison and watch live animal shows in season. Plus there's a playground, café and winter skating. The zoo also has ziplining for adults and children.

If you'd rather try an energetic adventure that will get the blood pumping, **Sky Zone Indoor Trampoline Park** offers all the jumping you can take. Try fitness classes, toddler time, birthday parties, dodgeball tournaments, charity events and more.

At nearby **Arnold's Family Fun Center**, kids will flip for Go-Karts, bumper cars, Crazy Kars, a flight simulator, the Frog Hopper, a carousel, black-light miniature golf, a bounce zone, duckpin bowling, laser tag, 200 arcade games and a rock-climbing wall.

When you work up an appetite, feast at a bistro or pizza-and-salad buffet.

Just after the Civil War, the last spike was driven on the **Colebrookdale Railroad**, linking Pottstown with nearby ironworks. The line was described as running through the "Secret Valley," a testament to its secluded, scenic beauty. Now that it has been meticulously restored, the views from the 1920s passenger cars are stunning. Kids will get a mini history lesson to complement the 8.5-mile ride.

CYCLING & HIKING

With 55 miles of interconnected trails that take you all through Montgomery County, there's a lot to explore.

Hike or bike alongside the Perkiomen Creek on a 20-mile trail that follows the old rail bed of the Reading Railroad. The **Perkiomen Trail** connects to the **Schuylkill River Trail** just outside **Valley Forge National Historical Park**, for those seeking some extra scenic mileage.

Don't stop there. Enjoy the great outdoors by bike or foot on the following trails: **Chester Valley Trail** in Bridgeport, **Cross County Trail** in Conshohocken, **Pennypack Trail** in Rockledge, and **Wissahickon Trail** in North Penn.

If you'd rather saddle up, you can do so at **Red Buffalo Ranch**. Ride a horse during a guided trail ride, matched to your skill level, through 3,500-acre **Evansburg State Park**. From May to November, you can embark on an overnight trail ride with gourmet feasts and cozy camping under the stars.

NIGHTLIFE

If you think Montgomery County days are ripe with adventures, shopping, entertainment and family-friendly outings, you should see us when the sun goes down.

Enter the **Valley Forge Casino Resort**. The thrill is tangible as you walk onto the casino floor amid the sparkling lights, snap of cards and whoosh of roulette wheels with more than 35,000 square feet of thrills, filled with 600 slot machines and 50 live gaming tables.

Take a break from gambling to dance at the **Cameo Lounge**, where DJs spin the newest music, or ride a mechanical bull at **Deuces Wild**.

Live entertainment will wow you with chart-topping headliners at the **Valley Forge Casino Resort Music Fair**, located in King of Prussia. Whether you come for someone like legendary performer Smokey Robinson, hilarious Dave Attell or your personal favorite act, this state-of-the-art entertainment venue is a must-see.

Sunnybrook Ballroom has been a renowned dance emporium since 1931, and is the third largest ballroom in the nation. Once the kings of swing played here in Pottstown; now it's where DJs, live musicians and dance enthusiasts love to get down.

You don't have to head into the city for a true taste of South Philly. Just stop at **Chickie's and Pete's** in Audubon. Fondly known as the #1 sports bar in North America, Chickie's hosts it all, including twisted trivia nights, sports events broadcast on multiple screens, karaoke, live radio shows, throwback dance parties and lots of live music.

Every day is a good day for fun and games. At **Dave & Busters**, Plymouth Meeting, Monday Night Football is best watched with a crowd of rabid fans. When it's not football season, the screens are filled with basketball, hockey and baseball—it's always a good time to stop by and connect with like-minded fans.

Live music on Thursdays through Sundays at **Bahama Breeze** in King of Prussia, combined with the Caribbean cuisine, makes for a laid-back getaway with an island vibe. Hand-crafted tropical drinks like the Bahamarita or Mango Mojito pair perfectly with the coconut shrimp and conch fritters while you enjoy the tunes.

At **Stone & Key Cellars** in Montgomeryville, you can work side by side with professional winemakers to produce your very own 59-gallon barrel of wine—that's about 285 bottles! You can also go smaller with a half- or quarter-barrel. It's great for group events, team-building and your personal collection.

Come to the **Blue Bell Inn** and experience one of Montco's favorite nightlife destinations. Enjoy the live music, delicious cuisine, artisanal cocktails and unbeatable ambiance complemented with firepits, fountains and rustic-meets-modern décor.



CHOOSE YOUR BREW

Whether it's the **Sly Fox Brewing Company** in Pottstown or the **Rock Bottom Restaurant and Brewery** in King of Prussia, Montco Brew Pubs have access to the highest quality ingredients. Montgomery County sits in an agricultural "sweet spot," where local water, grain, yeast and hops make for a satisfying local craft beer experience.

You'll find a wide sampling of micro-brews at **Audubon Ale House**, with more than 30 options from Allagash White Ale to Yard's Brawler. Or try **Taphouse 23** in Bridgeport—as the name suggests, 23 beers are available on tap, along with great live music on weekends, from acoustic folk to blues.

Manatawny Still Works in Pottstown has an active calendar of nighttime entertainment to go along with its finely crafted spirits. During live music performances, the crowd often spills out onto the lawn beside the tasting room, especially on summer evenings when the tunes inspire impromptu dancing under the stars.

Appalachian Brewing Company in Collegetown is perfect for a beer lover's night out. Pair up a medley of delicious craft brews with pub fare, such as mouth-watering chicken pot pie or a hearty Angus burger.

UNPLUG

Take in the captivating scenery at a beautiful park or relax riverside, make time to unwind at a luxurious spa or treat yourself to tee time. In Montgomery County, it's easy to enjoy a well-deserved break.





The John James Audubon Center at Mill Grove is the perfect place to take in the scenery and wildlife. This 175-acre sanctuary is an excellent venue for birdwatchers. It's easy to appreciate the property, from the 18th century house to the nine miles of trails. If you'd rather get off the beaten path, try a canoe tour. A resident canoe and wildlife expert will take you on an unforgettable glide down the **Perkiomen Creek**.

Central Perkiomen Valley Park is situated along the scenic creek that gives this retreat its name. Eight hundred acres offer plenty of space to toss a Frisbee or spread out a blanket and unwind. Visitors can enjoy a children's playground as well as vistas of the Perkiomen Creek while fishing. Picnic tables and grills are available throughout the park's picnic grove.

Rich in historical significance, **Fort Washington State Park** comes to life in spring when it blooms with flowering dogwood. The park was the site of a temporary fort built by George Washington's troops in the fall of 1777 before heading to Valley Forge. You can bike and picnic here, and birders can enjoy seasonal migrations from the observation deck.

Evansburg State Park in Collegeville offers expansive greenery at just a short ride from urban bustle. The **Skippack Creek** divides the land into ridges and valleys that create quiet spaces and provide scenic views. The creek is stocked with brown and rainbow trout before Memorial Day; you also can cast a line for bass, carp and catfish from the fishing dock in the picnic area.

If you prefer nature meticulously and magnificently portrayed, take in the perfection of the **Chanticleer Gardens**, spread across 35 acres on a once-private country estate in Wayne. There are woodlands, ruins, streams and orchards, open April to October.

There's no better way to leave your cares behind than by actually leaving the earth's surface. Floating over the beautiful Southeastern Pennsylvania countryside with the **U.S. Hot Air Balloon Team** is an unforgettable outing.

George Washington, our most famous visitor, brought along more than 12,000 war-weary militiamen, along with their muskets, cannons, provisions and families. We expect you'll be accompanied by a slightly smaller troop!

By Road

- Montgomery County is served by Exits 326 through 343 of the Pennsylvania Turnpike, coming from both east (N.J.) and west (Harrisburg, Pittsburgh).
- For Valley Forge National Historical Park, King of Prussia Mall and the Valley Forge Casino Resort, take exit 326.
- The Schuylkill Expressway (I-76) is your best bet from Philadelphia or Atlantic City.
- From Philadelphia International Airport, take I-476 (the Blue Route) north and then the Schuylkill Expressway (I-76) west.
- U.S. Route 202 provides easy access from Delaware and points south.
- Visitors from the north (New York, New England) or south (Maryland, D.C., Virginia) can reach our area on I-95.

By Air

All major airlines serve nearby Philadelphia International Airport. Northeast Philadelphia Airport caters to charter business travelers, both domestically and internationally. And within the county, Wings Field and Pottstown Municipal Airport are options.

By Train

Amtrak can whisk you from New York or Washington, D.C., to Philadelphia's 30th Street Station in a flash. From there, Montgomery County is accessible by cab, trolley, regional rail or limo. Amtrak also offers limited service to Ardmore and Paoli Stations, where ground transportation connects to local destinations.

The Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (we call it SEPTA) has an extensive network of trains and trolleys that link our area with Center City Philadelphia. The closest stops are Paoli Station and Norristown Transportation Center.

By Bus

SEPTA bus Route 125 connects downtown Philadelphia with destinations such as Valley Forge National Historical Park, Valley Forge Casino Resort and King of Prussia Mall.

Weather & Traffic

You can get the 411 on weather and traffic conditions thanks to 511. This Pennsylvania Department of Transportation service lets you check conditions via mobile, tablet or computer while in transit or before you leave the house. Check for updates by visiting the 511PA website or, if you're in the area, dialing 511.

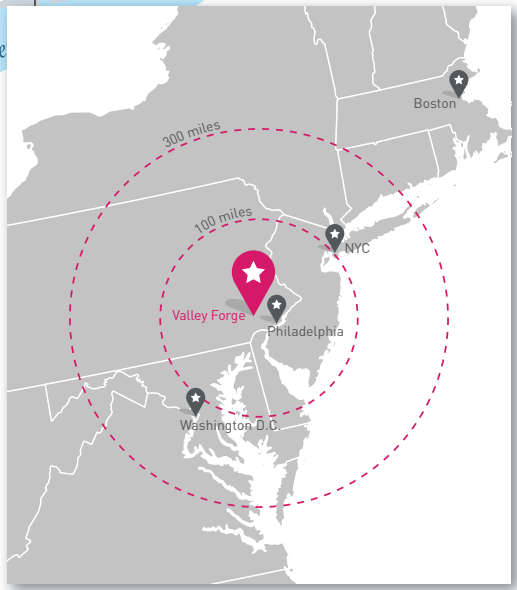
