1. Room Occupancy Tax Collections

November 2014 New Hanover County gross ROT collections (1st 3%) were up 9.37% as compared to the same month of the prior year. Fiscal year-to-date (July 2014–November 2014), New Hanover County gross ROT collections (1st 3%) are up 11.59% and calendar year-to-date (January 2014-November 2014) are up 10.69%.
