

A MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR



2015-2016 has been a breakthrough year for the York County Convention & Visitors Bureau. In cooperation with our state legislative delegation, Governor Tom Wolf in April signed into law Act 18, providing the opportunity of equal tourism funding to 57 counties throughout Pennsylvania. In May 2016, following Act 18 guidelines, the York County Commissioners voted unanimously to increase the county's hotel tax from 3 percent to 5 percent. We would like to thank all our state and county officials for pursuing this increase in funding, which is expected to give tourism in York County a boost of about \$1.2 million.

The YCCVB Board of Directors has been working diligently to ensure that the revenues collected from York County's room tax will be handled in accordance with the law. At the same time, we are instituting a York County Tourism Grant Program that will allow for annual and multi-year grants to organizations and businesses for tourism-related projects. Over the last year, a Tourism Grant Task Force comprised of highly qualified community volunteers has been developing the process for grant applications. We thank them for their efforts as we now move forward with a formal Grant Committee and anticipate opening the first grant rotation in early 2017.

Our mission continues as we maximize tourism expenditures and their economic impact in York County. We will PROMOTE York County as a place to visit and explore, MAXIMIZE tourism expenditures with overnight stays for greater economic impact, FOSTER an exceptional visitor experience with our tourism partners, and BUILD AND NURTURE industry, member and community relationships.

York County's Tourism Industry Creates Economic Impact, Tax Relief and Local Jobs.





York County's tourism industry generates more than \$90 million in state and local taxes each year. This translates into direct tax relief for all York County residents.



The tourism industry employs more than 7,637 people in York County.

MARKETING YORK COUNTY

Oxford Economics finds that destination promotion fuels development across the entire economic spectrum. In addition to generating jobs and tax revenues by attracting visitors, the activities of destination marketing organizations (DMOs) drive broader economic growth by sustaining air service, creating familiarity, attracting decision makers and improving the quality of life for residents.

To increase our share of the travel market, the York County CVB purchases advertising mainly beyond a 50-mile radius and uses multiple strategies to effectively market the county to leisure travelers, meeting planners, group tour operators, sport and tournament organizers and travel media.

Our strategy for effective marketing includes a combination of earned, paid and owned media.

EARNED MEDIA PITCHING:

Media stories outside radius.

PAID MEDIA ADVERTISING:

Paid marketing outside radius. Paid ads and promotions on social media.




YORK COUNTY CVB REVENUE

York County Convention & Visitors Bureau's Income.




YORK COUNTY CVB EXPENSES





ACT 18 Signed into Law

Governor Wolf signed ACT 18 into law and provided 57 counties, including York County, the option to raise their maximum hotel room tax from 3 percent to 5 percent to support local tourism promotion efforts. The law



levels a previously uneven playing field and allows further investment in York County, home to engaging factory tours, historical attractions, and the Mason-Dixon Wine and Susquehanna Ale trails.

York has strong ties to the law. Representative Keith Gillespie, R-York, sponsored the legislation, and Senator Scott Wagner, R-York, championed it in his chamber. Beverly Mackereth, the former state representative and current lobbyist, worked tirelessly to advance the bill.

The York County Board of Commissioners voted to increase York County's hotel room tax from 3 percent to 5 percent further investing in local tourism efforts that benefit the entire community.

PUBLIC RELATIONS

The York County CVB's media strategies generated significant results as we leveraged traditional and non-traditional media opportunities.

*The York County CVB secured more than 500 media pickups throughout the 2015-16 year, with hits in more than 40 states, including Pennsylvania, New York, Florida, California and others.

*York County attractions were featured in The Louisville Courier-Journal, Good Morning Washington and Go Escape (USA Today's Travel Magazine). Those pickups alone were worth more than \$100,000 in earned media.

*The York County CVB traveled to New York for a media mission with the Pennsylvania Tourism Office, forging new connections with travel writers from various publications. The CVB also attended the annual Mid-Atlantic Tourism Public Relations Alliance's Media Marketplace in Erie, PA.
