Newport Mansions Wine & Food Festival, Sept. 21 - 24: Held in one of the most spectacular settings in America, this remarkable weekend experience features hundreds of wines from around the world, fabulous food, celebrity chefs and cooking demonstrations, educational seminars, special events and a gala celebration. newportmansions.org/events/wine-and-food-festival

Bristol Burger Bash, Oct. 1: Burgers, beer and bluegrass! Bowen's Wharf 27th Annual Seafood Festival, Oct. 14 - 15: Honoring the "Harvest of the Sea," this ever-expanding event features lobsters, clam chowder, stuffed quahogs, clam cakes, shrimp, scallops, raw oysters and clams as well as dishes for landlubbers and kids in a festival atmosphere along the waterfront. Trinity Church's Annual Pumpkin Patch, mid- to late-October: In the heart of downtown Newport, Queen Anne Square transforms into an autumnal epicenter with thousands of pumpkins for sale, artisan crafts, live music on the weekends and hot apple cider.
