

Conventions and conferences are an integral part of the history of Saratoga Springs. Since the 1830s, many organizations including political parties, women's rights groups, temperance groups, religious groups, professional organizations and veterans' groups - have held conferences, meetings and conventions in Saratoga Springs.

Originally, the large meeting room atop of what is now City Hall was where many of meetings took place. Conventions grew so rapidly that Saratoga had to build a Convention Hall. The zenith was probably the Civil War veteran's "encampment" in 1907. Forty-thousand veterans came to Saratoga for that event.

Over time, the grand hotels and resorts that enabled Saratoga's conventions aged dramatically and finally demolished. Unable to accommodate conventioneers, the number of conventions in Saratoga Springs declined rapidly. By 1960, there were only nine conventions in the city. The end of the early convention era was marked by the 1965 fire that destroyed the Convention Hall

In 1984, the opening of the Saratoga Springs City Center marked the new era of conventions and events in Saratoga. The size, 37,000 square feet, enabled a variety of configurations and concurrent gatherings. The City Center was an immediate success and was so successful that an expansion was called for. In 2009, the City Center broke ground to expand the facilities by 65% and to enhance the architectural features. It is now home to a myriad of events from tech conferences to business services trade shows to outdoor sports expos to craft beer festivals.

New hotels in and around Saratoga Springs sprung up to meet the demand for rooms. Events at the City Center were bringing in over 100,000 visitors per year. These include The Saratoga Hilton, adjacent to the City Center, Hampton Inn & Suites Downtown Saratoga, Courtyard Marriott, Residence Inn by Marriott in



Saratoga and in Clifton Park, Embassy Suites and Pavilion Grand Hotel. The Hilton Garden Inn, Holiday Inn Saratoga Springs and Longfellows renovated and expanded, offering both rooms and meeting/event facilities.

The historic establishments - The Inn At Saratoga, The Gideon Putnam, Saratoga Arms, The Batcheller Mansion, for example - now provide the elegance of a bygone era coupled with modern amenities. In addition, there is the plethora of B&Bs and smaller motels with a charm of their own.

Just outside the city and just-off-the-highway are the hotels in the Malta and Clifton Park area. The Roosevelt Inn & Suites, Hyatt Place and Fairfield Inn & Suites by Marriott are located in Malta, Saratoga Spring's immediate neighbor to the south. A few miles farther south on I-87 are Clifton Park's Best Western, Hampton Inn and Hilton Garden Inn. All of these hotels also provide facilities and amenities for events.

Early visitors included Daniel Webster, James Fenimore Cooper, Edgar Allen Poe and Nathaniel Hawthorne. In the mid 1800s, the construction of the Canfield Casino and the surrounding grounds introduced upscale gambling.

This attracted the likes of Diamond Jim Brady, Lillian Russell, the Vanderbilt's, the Whitney's, et al. Shops, boutiques and restaurants soon proliferated on Broadway, Saratoga's main thoroughfare, to meet every need and desire of these pioneering one-percenters. Saratoga and world-class horseracing are synonymous. Sports Illustrated named the Saratoga Race Course one of the Top Ten





Sporting Venues in the world. Besides thoroughbred racing, there is also harness racing at night and casino gambling. But there is so much more to do in the Saratoga area.


Opened in 1935 on the grounds of the New York State Reservation at Saratoga Springs – now known as the Saratoga Spa State Park – is the Colonial Revival/Neo-Georgian style Gideon Putnam Hotel. The architectural mandate was to be elegant but not overly ornate. In keeping with the theme Dorothy Tuckerman Draper, the interior designer of the Greenbrier Resort, created the interior motif.

Also located in Saratoga Spa State Park is The Hall of Springs. The former orchestral music hall denotes grandeur, with high vaulted ceilings, marble floors and columns, Belgian crystal chandeliers and stone figures cut by Austrian stonecutters

Another popular historic venue is the Canfield Casino, located in the middle of Congress Park. It was built in 1867 by John Morrissey who was immortalized in Herbert Ashbury's 1928 book, "The Gangs of New York." It began as one of the world's most renowned gambling establishments. It is now owned by the city of Saratoga Springs and is the host of some of Saratoga's most elaborate parties, weddings and events.
