Chapel Hill/Orange County Visitors Bureau Produces New Countywide Restaurant Map

Chapel Hill, NC - (November 20, 2017) – The Chapel Hill/Orange County Visitors Bureau has published a first-ever Orange County Restaurants Map.

The maps, in tear-off pads of 50, list restaurants in downtown Chapel Hill, Carrboro and Hillsborough as well as other Hillsborough and Carrboro dining options on the front side, while restaurants by address and districts noting North, East and South Chapel Hill are listed on the back side. Hotels are also included on the map to help visitors find restaurants near those venues. There are more than 340 dining options listed on the map.

The maps are free and can be found at Visitor Centers on Franklin Street, the UNC campus and in Hillsborough, and at the hotels.
