

101 THINGS TO DO AND SEE ON THE COAST

1. Hike or bike the newly opened Devil's Slide Trail, a 1.3 mile long paved cliff trail overlooking the Pacific. Trail open 24/7.

3. Hike or bike along Highway 1, enjoying sweeping views of the Pacific Ocean, access to several beaches and excellent nature viewing and bird watching. Start at Highway 1 & Kelly Ave. **Half Moon Bay R/P**

4. Head to San Pedro Valley Park, a walker's paradise, and climb to the top of Montara Mountain. Stop at the visitor center to learn about the ecosystem. parks.smcgov.org 600 Oddstad Rd. **Pacifica R/P**

5. Choose one of a multitude of trails to hike in the 8,020 acres of Pescadero Creek Park, including San McDonald, Memorial, and Heritage Grove parks. 9500 Pescadero Creek Rd. **Pescadero/Loma Mar R/P**

6. Hike or bike the trail on Linda Mar Beach (Pacifica State Beach), rent a surf board or kayak or join a summer surf camp. cityofpacifica.org, Highway 1 and San Pedro Avenue **Pacifica S/P**

7. Play a round on the Ocean Course at Half Moon Bay Golf Links. Enjoy a view of the Pacific from all 18 holes. Two Miramontes Point Road. halfmoonbaygolf.com **Half Moon Bay S/P**

8. Head to Costanoa Lodge & Camp for a trail ride on horseback, mid-April thru October. Reservations required. This eco

13. Play a round of golf at Sharp Park Golf Course, an Alistair McKenzie course with views of the Pacific, or just drop into the historic club house. sharpparkgc.ghin-club.com, Highway 1 & Sharp Park Road **Pacifica S/R/P**

14. Head to San Gregorio State Beach, a mile-long shoreline with sandy coves, rocky cliffs, tide pools, fishing spots and picnic areas. Located 14.5 miles south of Half Moon Bay on Highway 1. pescadero-california.com/state-beaches **Pescadero R/P**

15. Tour the Point Montara Lighthouse, located 25 miles south of San Francisco on Highway 1 between Montara and Moss Beach. Look for hostel signs. parks.ca.gov **Montara H/C/P**

16. Check out the Pacifica Pier and even try your hand at fishing. pacificapier.com 2100 Beach Blvd. **Pacifica R/P**

17. Play a different round at Half Moon Bay Golf Links, taking on the Scottish Links course. halfmoonbaygolf.com Two Miramontes Point Road **Half Moon Bay S/P**

18. Enjoy a 30-minute guided history walk around the Pigeon Point lighthouse grounds, available 10-4, Fri-Mon, except on rainy days. parks.ca.gov **Pescadero H/C/P**

19. Pomponio State Beach is rimmed by towering sandstone bluffs and allows access to miles of beaches. At low tide it is possible to hike to San Gregorio State Beach to the north and

Pescadero State beach to the south. parks.ca.gov **Pescadero R/P**

20. Do some tide pooling and picture taking at Fitzgerald Marine Reserve. Time your trip for low tide. For tours, hours and tide table, call 650-728-3584. 200 Nevada St. fitzgeraldreserve.org **Moss Beach C/P**

21. Check out the birds, blue heron, kites, deer, raccoons, foxes and skunks at the Pescadero Marsh Natural Preserve, a popular spot for bird watchers and other naturalists. 650-879-2170, pescadero-california.com/state-beaches Located on Highway 1. **Pescadero R/P**

22. Venture over to Cowell Ranch Beach on Highway 1, where scenes from "Bicentennial Man" with Robin Williams were filmed. californiasbestbeaches.com/half_moon_bay **Half Moon Bay R/P**

23. Picnic or explore tide pools at Bean Hollow Beach or take the self-guided nature trail. Located on Highway 1. parks.ca.gov **Pescadero R/P**

24. Park just south of The Ritz-Carlton and take a walk along the ocean, passing the edges of the Scottish links golf course. (Just short of Two Miramontes Point Road, on left.) **Half Moon Bay R/P**

25. Head to the four beaches that make up a two-mile stretch of sand along Half Moon Bay State Beach: Roosevelt Beach, Dunes Beach, Venice Beach, and Francis Beach. californiasbestbeaches.com/half_moon_bay Kelly Avenue, just west of Highway 1 **Half Moon Bay R/P**

26. Check out the grounds of Pigeon Point Lighthouse, built in 1872. facebook.com/PigeonPointLighthouse Located on Highway 1, 20 miles south of Half Moon Bay. **Pescadero H/P**

27. Visit the renowned Ano Nuevo State Park, where giant elephant seals return to breed, give birth, and molt. Tours offered only by appointment from December-March; self-guided tours the

remainder of the year. Reservations: anonuevo.reserveamerica.com One New Year's Creek Rd. **Pescadero R/C/P**

28. Pick your own fruit at Swanton Berry Farm. Call for availability: 831-469-8804 swantonberryfarm.com **Pescadero R/F**

29. Take the kids to Frontierland Park, complete with an extensive playground, barbecues and horseshoe pits. cityofpacifica.org, Oddstad Blvd. and Yosemite Dr. **Pacifica R/P**

30. If you're in the area in the fall, try winding your way through the two-acre Minotaur's labyrinth hay maze at Arata Pumpkin Farm. aratapumpkinfarm.com 650-726-7548, 185 Verde Rd. **Half Moon Bay R/P**

31. Bring your skateboard and try out the Pacifica Skate Park, cityofpacifica.org, 540 Crespi Dr., or the Cunha Skate Park in Half Moon Bay on Kelly St., just east of Highway 1. iskatehere.com/spot/99 **Pacifica/Half Moon Bay S**

33. Are you a “clothing optional” kind of person? Head to Gray Whale Cove, parks.ca.gov, 650-726-8819 (North of Montara on Highway 1. Only available parking is east of Hwy 1, use extreme care.) Or, head to San Gregorio Beach (entrance on the west side of Hwy 1, just north of its intersection with CA Hwy 84.) **Montara/Pescadero R**

34. Take your dog for a walk on the dog-friendly Miramar Beach. Off-leash allowed. Mirada Road & Highway 1 **Half Moon Bay R**

35. Take the scenic drive from Highway 1 and Highway 92, going west on 92 for five miles, then east on Highway 35, stopping at Thomas Fogarty Winery to

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taste the Santa Cruz appellation and take in a great view of vineyards and San Francisco Bay. Continue on Hwy 35, turn right onto Hwy 84, to enjoy the Giant Redwood forests. Turn left onto Pescadero Creek Rd, with views of farmland, until you reach Hwy 1. Turn right onto Highway 1 to finish along the ocean. **Half Moon Bay/Woodside/Pescadero R/A/P**

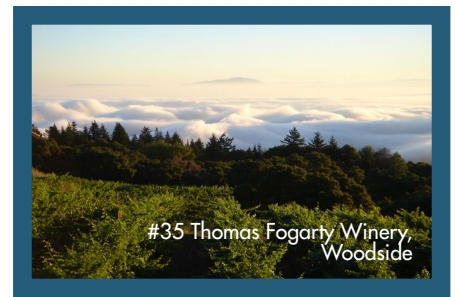

42. Take a strenuous hike (or bike) up Montara Mountain in McNee Ranch State Park for fantastic ocean views. bahiker.com/southbayhikes/mcneeranch From Highway 1, drive about 4 miles south of the last Pacifica traffic signal at Linda Mar. Turn left into the small parking lot. **Pacifica S/R/P**

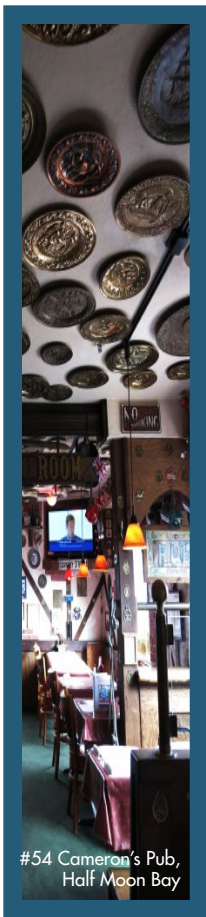

Pescadero Creek, which flows all year round, is a major Steelhead spawning stream. parks.smcgov.org/pescadero-creek-park 650-879-0238 Take Highway 1 to Pescadero Road and head inland about 11 miles to the park entrance. **Loma Mar/Pescadero S/R/P**

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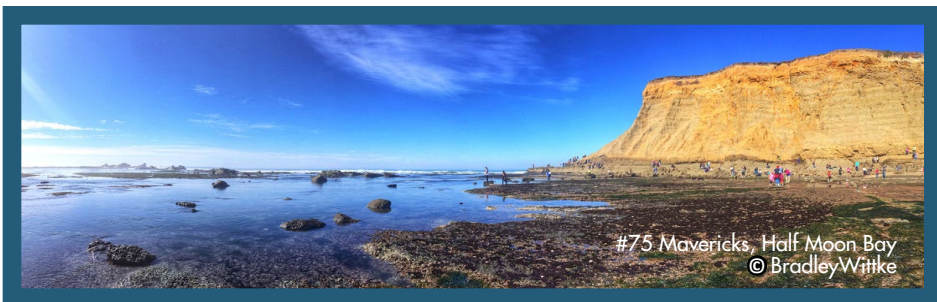

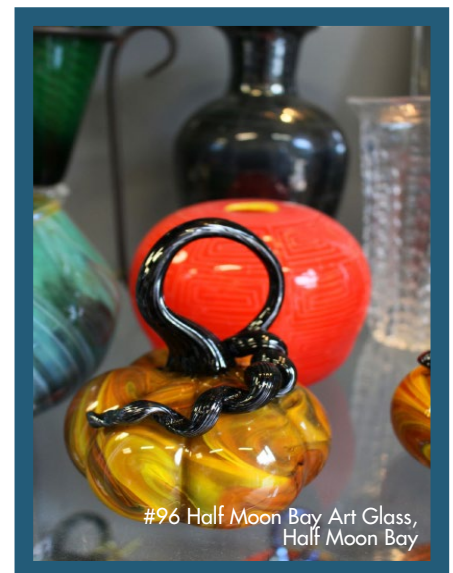

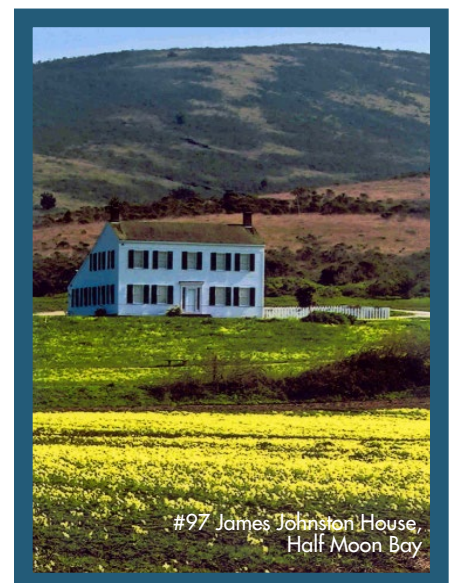
