Application Instructions

Leadership NOW – Optimizing Leadership Effectiveness seeks to prepare individuals for the challenges they face as leaders. The program is designed to provide individuals the skills and knowledge necessary to lead with intention and develop, initiate and sustain collaborative projects. Leadership NOW – Optimizing Leadership Effectiveness focuses special attention on self-discovery, leadership competencies and styles, building and managing a diverse team, group dynamics, creating a culture of inquiry, accountability, ethics, change management and conflict resolution. The program is intended for those who are committed to doing their best for the communities and organizations they serve.

Leadership NOW - Optimizing Leadership Effectiveness will nurture professional leaders who wish to study the development of effective collaborations.

Criteria & Qualifications

- Applicant must live and/or work in Genesee County
- Applicant must work in the public or private sector
- Applicant must attend one of the required information sessions
- Applicant must have a willingness to participate fully in all aspects of the Leadership Now Optimizing Leadership Effectiveness program, including post program evaluations
- Applicant must be open to activities that involve self-reflection and continuous learning
- · Applicant must have a desire to enhance leadership, management, relationship building and collaboration skills
- Applicant must commit to taking his/her learning to action in their place of employment and/or community; they will be asked to demonstrate how they intend to apply the learning to a current workplace collaboration activity or shared service
- Applicant must have his/her employer's support and confirmation of time commitment to participate in the Leadership NOW - Optimizing Leadership Effectiveness program

Program Requirements

- Timely completion of the Leadership Effectiveness Analysis[™] (LEA)
- Attend 90% of full day sessions
- Develop a calendar for coaching sessions
- Applicant must come with a readiness to develop and have as commitment to collaborative partnerships
- Develop a collaborative project
- Applicants must attend the Introductory Session scheduled for Friday, January 25, 2019 from 1 5:00 p.m.

Application Information

Documents to be included with your Leadership NOW - Optimizing Leadership Effectiveness application:

- A personal statement specific to the applicant's leadership philosophy and goals for development. It should convey to the reader a sense of who the applicant is. The statement should be a minimum of 100 words and maximum of 250 words
- Your typewritten responses to the eight (8) questions on the application, minimum of 100 words and maximum of 250 words per question
- A letter of recommendation from an immediate supervisor noting approval of the time commitment. The letter should be specific to the applicant's leadership and collaborative traits
- Resume; please include hobbies and interests

Application Deadline
