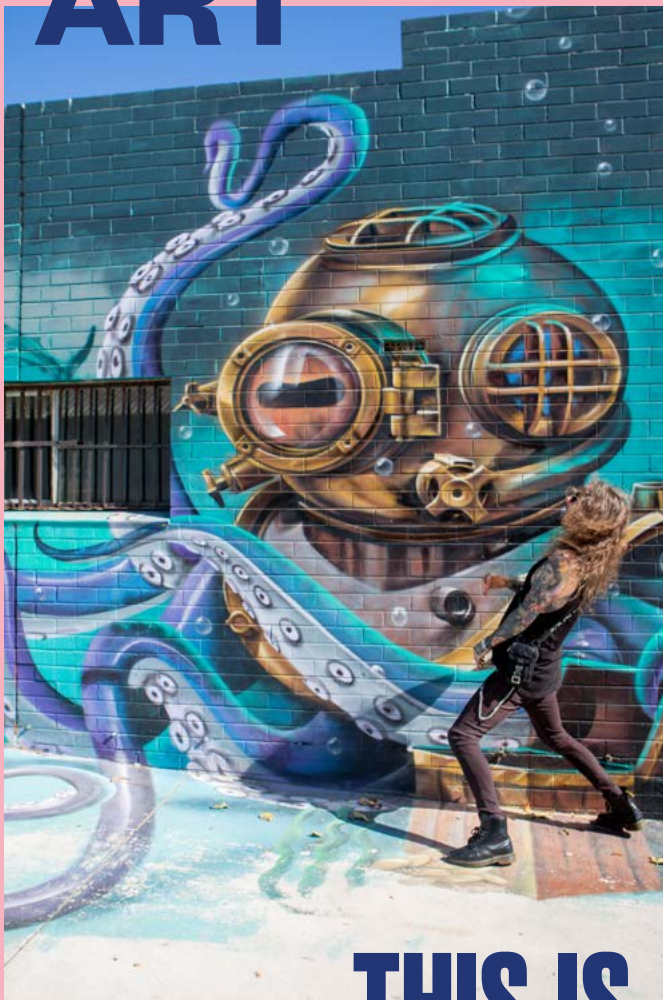

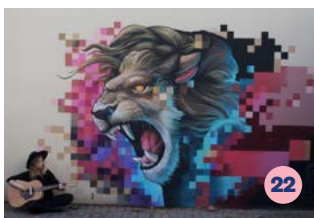
Anita Revel (WA)

An ever-evolving work in progress on the side of Gino's Cafe, you can often find the artist, Horatio T Birdbath, working on this piece.



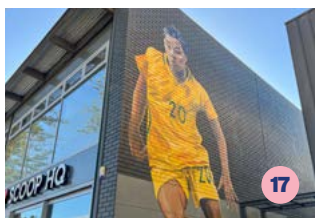
Holly Ogden (WA)

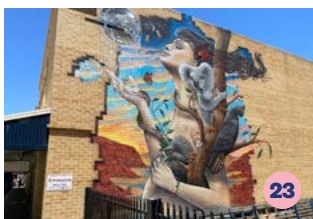
Morag Myerscough (ENG)
