

2 types:

Meaningful Minimal Pairs

child is stimulable for targets.

- Familiarization
 - Provide simple descriptions for each picture card
- Listening
 - You state the target word then child picks up or points to target word
 - 90% accuracy then move to next step
- Production in words
 - Contrast minimal pair words in drill-play
 - Production in phrases, sentences, and conversation
 - Begin with structured sentences then reduce the structure to more conversational speech in play based child-led activities

Remember: Aim for 100+ trials per session

Perception Production Minimal Pairs

child is not stimulable for targets.

- Familiarization
 - Provide simple descriptions for each picture card
- Listening
 - Pick up target words, sort target words into respective categories, or place word into motivating objects
 - 90% accuracy to move to next step
- Production (imitation)
 - You provide a model of target words and the child repeats
 - 90% accuracy to move to the next step
- Production (spontaneous)
 - No model from SLP
 - At least 50% accuracy for 50 trials
- Production
 - contrast minimal pairs in drill-play
- Production in phrases, sentences, conversation
 - Begin with structured sentences then reduce the structure to more conversational speech in play based child-led activities
