

transferred from Georgia State Prison to another prison because the other letters were not signed or otherwise identified the authors sufficiently, and he could not determine who wrote the other letters.

Again, another statement was written and signed by Ms. Diamond. She contends it was not voluntary. Prison officials who witnessed it contend that it was. We had clarification with regard to the specialized living unit. It's unclear -- there was some suggestion today whether or not it currently houses transgender inmates. But Ms. Brewton said most of the transgender inmates at Georgia State Prison are generally housed in the general population, she claims with no complaints by them in years past, as did Lieutenant Johnson, that is he denied having knowledge of any prior complaints from the transgender inmates at Georgia State Prison, with the exception of one call to the PREA, a hotline, which he investigated and that inmate, a transgender inmate, said he did not make -she did make that complaint. But with regard to the circumstances in the specialized living unit, it is a 13-cell facility. Ms. Diamond is in cell number 1 which the evidence is is in proximity to the video and the guards the closest of the 13 cells. As a result of clarification I got today, I understand now that there is a command post or control post within eyesight of that

unit that is manned 24 hours a day.

In addition, apparently this was done since our last hearing, a dorm officer, I believe the position was called, is now assigned there on a constant basis.

The door that was complained about that in the past apparently was not secured as perhaps it should have been, there's been changes made with regard to that so that it is secure. As Mr. Smith said and his counsel pointed out, can we say with certainty that there won't be some glitch or some failure to secure the door? That's certainly possible, but there have been changes made to ensure that the door will be secured.

Now, we heard compelling testimony from Ms.

Diamond this morning much of which did conflict with the testimony that we've heard from prison officials and I can't tell precisely where the truth lies at this point.

An example perhaps of the difficulty in that is the dining situation. And I should mention that too appears to be a change that has been made recently, whether not in response to Ms. Diamond's complaints, I don't know; but that inmates in the specialized living unit are, as a matter of course now, escorted to dining. As I understand it, Ms. Diamond hasn't denied additional escorts beyond that routine escort for reasons that she explained; particularly she is concerned about being a snitch or
