OVERDOSE FATALITIES CONTINUE TO RISE IN THE WORKPLACE

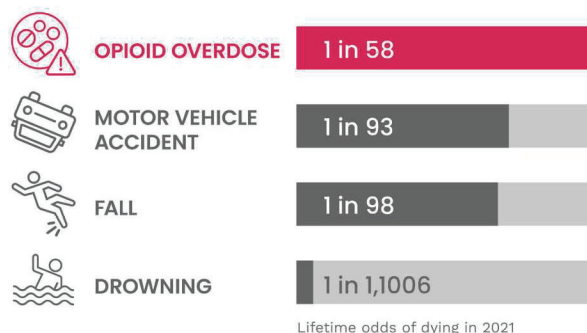

HOW TO HELP

Opioid emergencies can happen anytime, anywhere, in the workplace.

- **Educate**
talk to employees and workers, build a plan, share resources
- **Break the Stigma**
the epidemic does not discriminate
- **Be Prepared**
know the signs, have a plan, be prepared to respond quickly

BE PREPARED TO RECOGNIZE AN OPIOID EMERGENCY

Unusual sleepiness or unresponsiveness	Breathing will be slow or absent	Slow heartbeat or low blood pressure	Pupils are tiny	Skin feels cold or clammy	Nails and lips are blue

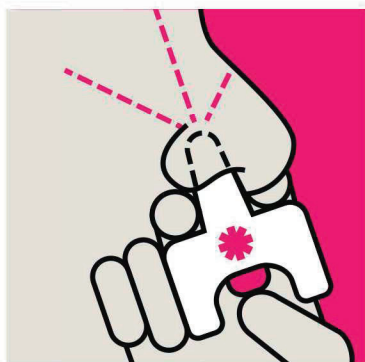


WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A SUSPECTED OPIOID EMERGENCY



LAY

- Check for slowed breathing or unresponsiveness.
- Lay the person on their back and tilt the head up.



SPRAY

- Insert device into either nostril and press plunger firmly.



STAY

- Call 911 immediately and continue to administer doses as needed.
