Safety Newsflash: Retained Guidewires




8 of the 16 <u>NEVER EVENTS</u> (reported over the past 2 years) in the ED are <u>RETAINED GUIDEWIRES</u> following chest drain and central line insertion

NRLS advice

Standardised process for guidewire management during central venous access:

- <u>Two person process</u> (operator and observer)
- <u>Visual confirmation</u> of guidewire removal by both persons
- <u>Verbal communication</u> of guidewire removal by both persons
- <u>Documentary confirmation</u> of guidewire removal by both persons
- <u>Training and education</u> to emphasise appropriate control of guidewires
