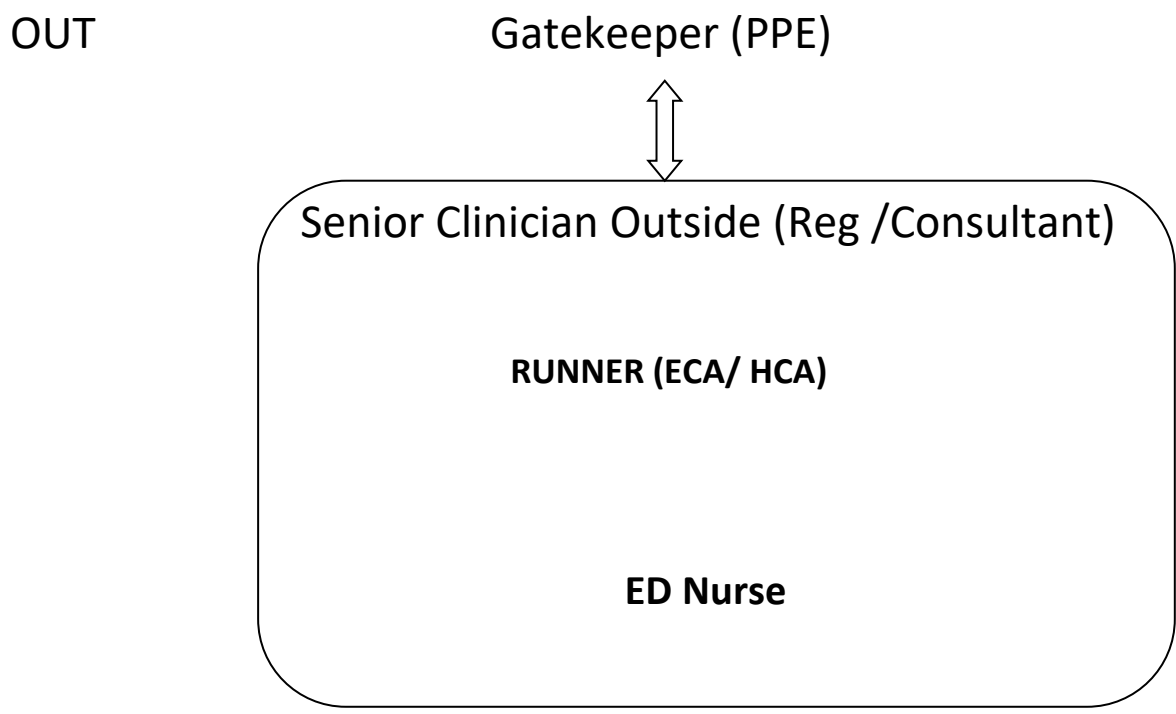
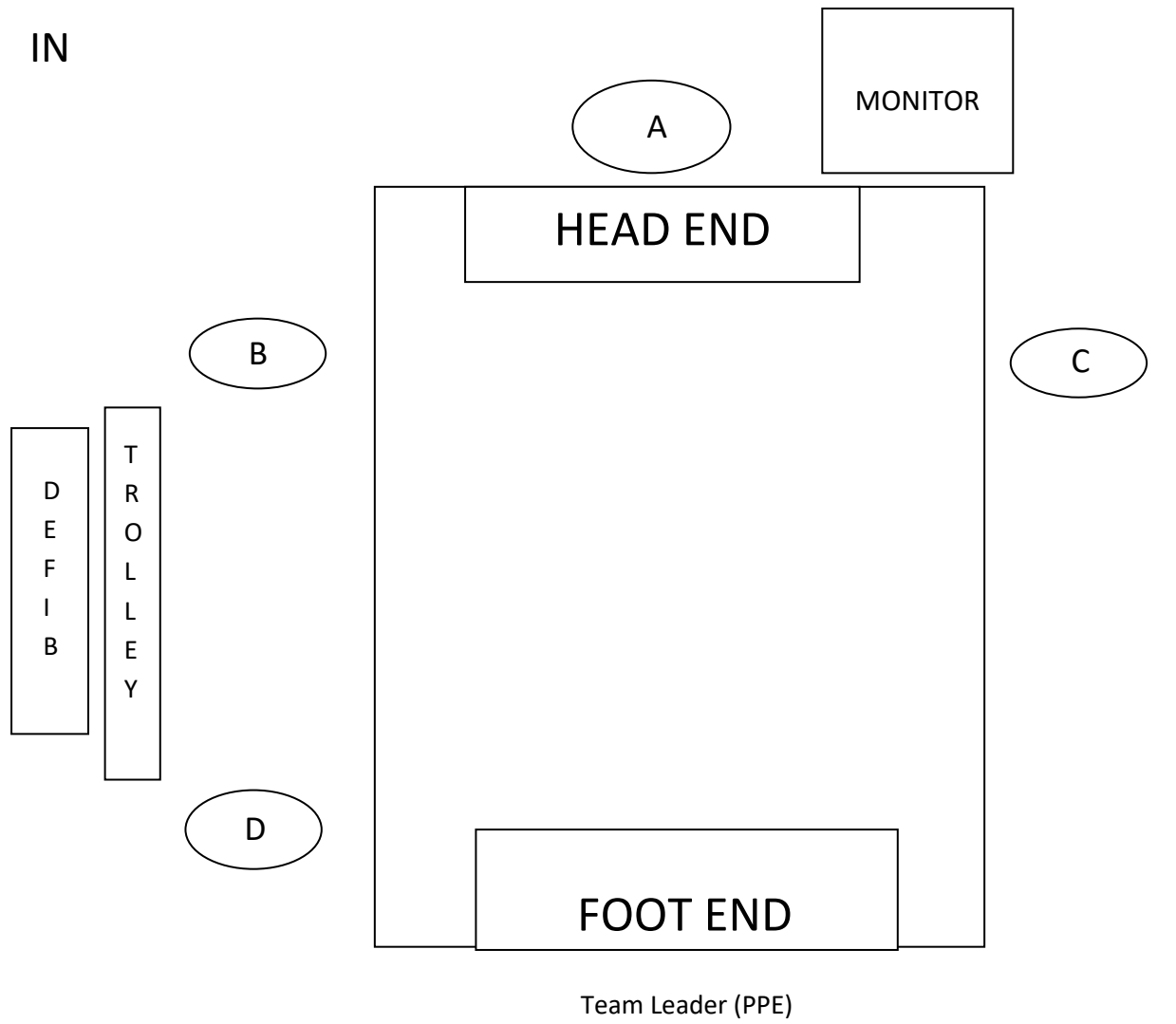

<p>A → Clinician (Airway Person)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full PPE with FFP3 Before Entering • Confirms cardiac arrest • Airway management • Liaise Team Leaders 	<p>B → ED Nurse</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full PPE with FFP3 before entering the room • Puts Defib pads on and Attach/Switch on Defib • Liaise with Team Leader
<p>C → ED HCA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Puts full PPE with FFP3 before entering the room • Put surgical mask or oxygen mask on patient before starting compressions • Starts chest compressions • Liaise with Team Leader 	<p>D → ED Nurse</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Puts Full PPE with FFP3 before entering the room • I/V Access + VBG • Starts I/V Fluids • Gives Adrenaline + Amiodarone • Liaise with Team Leader
<p>Gatekeeper → ED HCA/ ED nurse</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Puts on PPE with FFP3 and stands outside the door • Can open the door to help bring information to senior clinician outside 	

<p>Team leader inside → ALS Provider</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Puts full PPE (with FFP3) before entering the room ● Runs arrest scenario as per ALS guidelines ● Communicates with outside team leader via gate keeper <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ (Can open the door talk to the gate keeper or pass on a note.) ● Scribes and times. ● Arranges debrief session 	<p>Team leader outside (Decision maker) → Senior ED clinician</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● PPE as recommended for Isolation work station area ● Can communicate with the gate keeper to pass on information inside. ● Gets information to plan further (Via notes, Nexus etc). ● Liaise with Team leader IN via the gate keeper.
<p>ED nurse outside</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● PPE as recommended for Isolation work station area ● For preparing medications needed and trouble shooting ● Liaising with team leader outside and the Gatekeeper 	<p>Runner</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● PPE as recommended for isolation work station area ● For sending bloods, doing VBG etc. ● Liaising with the Gatekeeper
