## Installation Instructions

- 1. Park vehicle on a clean, flat surface and block the rear wheels for safety.
- 2. Disconnect the factory steering stabilizer for the axle and tie rod mounts. Save hardware.
- 3. Locate the provided bushings and sleeves. There is a 1-1/2" wide bushing/sleeve set and a 1-3/8" wide bushing/sleeve set. Lightly grease and install the 1-1/2" wide set in the ROD end of the stabilizer and the 1-3/8" set in the BODY end.
- 4. Install the new stabilizer in the factory mounts with the original hardware. The BODY end of the stabilizer will mount to the axle. Torque hardware to 55 ft-lbs.
- 5. Apply provided sticker and check hardware for proper torque.
- 6. Cycle steering to verify proper clearance.
