

LADYLIKE FOUNDATION Scholarship Guidelines

Who is Eligible: High School Senior Girls (no exceptions)

GPA: We must receive verification of GPA from high school of 3.5 or higher no exceptions (A copy of your transcript must be included in the application with a clearly stated GPA)

ESSAY TOPICS: Please be detailed, and transparent when sharing your story/testimonials.
(Please choose only 1 topic to answer)

IN A SEPARATE PARAGRAPH: Please share why the Ladylike Foundation is important to you.

1. If you are a participant of the LadyLike Foundation: How significant has your involvement in this organization been for you? What events or Girl Talk topics have been the most important to you? Could you share your most unforgettable moment from your time with the organization? What valuable lessons have you gained that you believe will benefit you in college and beyond? In what ways does the LadyLike Foundation positively influence teenage girls? Would you encourage other young women to join the LadyLike Foundation, and if so, why? Lastly, please explain how you have been inspired, empowered, and encouraged to become all that you could be through our organization.
2. What three qualities does a woman need to possess to be recognized as a "Woman of Excellence"? Can you think of someone who embodies these traits, and would you describe them as a Woman of Excellence? Lastly, what steps can one take to become a Woman of Excellence in the future?
3. As a young woman, what guidance do you believe is important to pass on to the next generation of young women, and why do you consider it significant?
4. How significant is women's empowerment in today's world? What are some methods through which women can support and uplift each other, and in what ways have you personally contributed to empowering other women?
5. Describe a challenge you've successfully addressed or one you would like to solve. This might involve an intellectual challenge, a research inquiry, an ethical dilemma, or any issue that holds personal significance, regardless of its magnitude. Elaborate on its importance to you and detail the steps you've undertaken or could undertake to find a solution.

ESSAY WORD COUNT: 350 word minimum, typed double-spaced in "Times New Roman" font.

(Last name, First name, high school or church affiliation on every page in upper right-hand corner. In addition, please write the number of the essay topic question on the first page of the essay. Be sure to answer ALL of the questions within your essay.)

Application Requirements: 2 letters of recommendation from a non-relative (the recommendations do not have to be sealed), a Resume that includes: jobs, internships, community, volunteer service, extracurricular activities, and the college that you plan to attend in the fall. Stating the college where you to in the fall is very important.

Photograph: Please include a color photograph of the applicant.

Applicants Contact Information: Applicants full name, parent/parents/guardian name, the best phone number to reach you, email, and mailing address must be included in the application packet.

Interviews: All finalists for the scholarship will be contacted and are required to participate in an interview with the Ladylike Foundation Board of Directors for final selection. Interviews are via Zoom. In order to qualify, the finalist must be present for the interview, and dressed in "Professional Attire." It is important to make a great first impression.

Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,500 - \$10,000.00 per recipient. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend the May 23, 2026 Luncheon at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel from 11am-2pm (If you are in town, if not you will be asked to film a virtual thank you acceptance for your award.) You must wear professional luncheon attire for the event in May, if you are awarded.

Once scholarship recipients have been selected by the LadyLike Foundation Board of Directors, the recipient's parent/parents/guardian will be contacted by telephone.

All items required in the scholarship application are non-returnable. The Ladylike Foundation will respect each applicant's privacy, but will not return any application packets.
