Guidelines for Prison Project Donations

The Prison Project is able to accept the following items for incarcerated students:

- SYDA Foundation publications and Darshan magazines
 - Items must be in good condition, free of water damage, not worn, and without any highlighted or underlined text.
 - Only softcover books accepted.
 - Exception: *The Nectar of Chanting*
 - o Items should not have mailing labels on the covers.
- CDs and DVDs published by the SYDA Foundation
 - o Items should not have any scratches.
- Photos
 - o Only photos of the Siddha Yoga Gurus accepted.
 - Photos of Gurumayi must be from 1990s or later.
 - o Photos must be in excellent condition.
 - o Only 3x5, 5x7, or 8x10 photos accepted.
 - Photos should not be laminated, mounted on wood or foam core, or framed.

The Prison Project cannot accept the following items:

- VHS or cassette tapes
- In Search of the Self or Siddha Yoga Home Study Course printed materials and included CDs
- Shawls, japa malas, or asanas
