#### Personal Statement

I am an amateur filmmaker hoping to improve my skills in the industry. I have some experience working on a professional set. Most recently, I worked on Outwith as a boom operator. It is a dystopian sci-fi film that hasn't been released yet. We shot it over one week and it included many difficult locations for audio recording, such as exteriors near a beach and interiors with no windows. Working on this film has increased my confidence to make sure to get the best sound on location that I can.

I have also worked on several student films such as through the University of Glasgow Filmmaking Society where we shot a 30 minute short film using my own filmmaking equipment. In my spare time I have also worked on a few 48 Hour Film Projects to try and increase the pressure on myself to put out a good quality product as quickly as possible.

During my time at University of Glasgow, I joined the Filmmaking Society, and I bought my own filmmaking equipment. So, I had to learn how to use a Blackmagic camera and Rode mics in a very short space of time to make the best use out of the equipment before we started filming. I also offered up my equipment and services to other crews in the society when they needed it, so I am used to working with different crews and teaching them how to use the

equipment quickly since they were also University students like me, so they have never used equipment like that before.

Out with the university, I volunteered at Broadcasting Scotland for a short period where I learned the basics of news broadcasting for their YouTube channel where they post weekly news updates live. I oversaw changing the camera when the news broadcaster finished reading the teleprompter and made guests comfortable and prepared them for their interviews.

At Ayrshire College, I learned how a student theatre production is run. We were given hands-on experience with all aspects of the process, including preproduction, such as, stage construction and set design. On the showing of the production, I oversaw sound mixing using a mixing desk and playing sound effects using my cue sheet.

I have previously completed my Bronze, Silver, and Gold Duke of Edinburgh awards where I learned how each member of a team can lift each other up to reach our full potential. To achieve these awards, we assisted different people in our local community. For example, we planted a washing line for a local hospice, we planted a tree and put together and painted several benches for our school. The awards significantly improved my social skills since we were always meeting new people each week to help them with a project. They also helped me develop my efficiency in completing tasks since we usually only had an hour to work on each project since we were working around our school timetables.
