NARRATOR The naughty boys shake their heads, denying what they did.

Scene two

NARRATOR

For interrupting sports day Emily has been separated from her friends, she is sitting next to some teachers along with Ted, Billy, and Callum. They are all looking very sorry for themselves.

> EMILY Mrs cleverly?

MRS CLEVERLY Yes Emily?

EMILY Those boys have spoilt my sports day.

MRS CLEVERLY Now Emily, we know you don't get on with them so we feel it best you stay put for now.

From the tannoy we hear Mr Hunchingson.

MR HUCHINGSON Year six a hundred meter's all taking part please report to the desk.

EMILY Mrs Cleverly that's me, can I still take part?

MRS CLEVERLY Let me find out.

NARRATOR

Mrs Cleverly gets the attention of the senior teacher who is looking after Billy, whilst the teachers are talking, Billy takes the opportunity and looks at Emily as he points to his Slingshot.

BILLY The next time I use this yeah, will be on your silly little bird. NARRATOR The other naughty boys start to laugh but Emily repeats to herself...

EMILY I must not react! I must not react!

NARRATOR She looks across the track and see's toby, she nods at him. Toby nods back. Emily looks back at Billy and Ted.

Ted reacts.

TED

Look, look its that crow. The crow is talking to Emily.

NARRATOR

The teachers tell ted and the others to be quiet, then Mrs Cleverly heads back to speak with Emily.

MRS CLEVERLY

Yes Emily, since you were sitting quietly you can take part and then you can go back to sit with your friends afterwards.

Emily can't believe her luck.

NARRATOR

Scene three

Music

NARRATOR

The naughty boys are hiding behind trees and bushes, waiting to ambush Austin and the girls.

BILLY This is awesome, why didn't we think of this before.

TED We got Austen good and proper. CALLUM

I'm worried this will backfire big time.

BILLY how?

CALLUM I don't know, it has feathers and rhymes with bow?

Ted looks worried.

BILLY They're coming, they're coming!

NARRATOR

Toby is high in the sky. Austen and the girls are cycling. Toby notices something moving in the bushes, the girls stop cycling but poor Austen carries on, oblivious.

Toby close by him. Billy shouts. Music stops.

BILLY ambush!

NARRATOR The boys all fire at toby the crow.

Narrator says in slow motion in slow motion. Toby misses two pieces of ammo, but the last one catches his wing. Toby stumbles in mid-air and flies off.

NARRATOR

Beat.

The naughty boys retreat back behind the bushes and trees to reload. Austen stays behind his bike to reload. Unfortunately the girls are too far up the road to help.

Saskia shouts.

SASKIA Austen are you okay!

AUSTEN

Yes, I've got a whole bag full of ammo.

The naughty boys from the bushes and the trees. Bushes and tree rustling sound.

CALLUM Billy did you hear that?

> BILLY Hear what!

TED He's got lots of ammo.

BILLY Then we will all run at him, together!

> TED Good idea.

Pause

BILLY ready!

CALLUM ready!

BILLY Ted ready!

Ted Slightly worried.

TED ready?

NARRATOR

Meanwhile up the road. Emily and the girls are coming up with a plan. The girl's see the naughty boys huddling together.

DONNA

I think the boys are up to something look!

SASKIA

I think Austen needs our help.

DONNA If we cycle down, we can help him.

SASKIA The quicker we do it the better.

EMILY

Let's go girls!

NARRATOR

They cycle down as fast as they can. Meanwhile further down the road, Austen jumps up from behind his bike and shoots. THE NAUGHTY BOYS charge!!

NARRATOR Callum is taken out and ted is hit on the leg.

TED Man down and he's got me on the leg.

BILLY Come on, we've nearly got him.

NARRATOR

Ted and Billy are just meters away, Billy pumped up runs towards Austin, but Austen points up at the sky.

AUSTEN Look, look who's come back to help.

NARRATOR The boys stop running and follow Austen's gaze.

TED Run, run to safety!!

Beat.	Emily is dancing around with toby.
