End scene 1

NARRATOR Mike not really listening.

End of scene 2

Beat.

ALISON So toby, do you actually know where we are doing?

TOBY awk, awk awk!

ALISON Okay that's interesting?

NARRATOR They walk further until it becomes too small for Alison to continue.

ALISON Toby, I'll stay here.

> TOBY awk!

ALISON

Is it me or can that crow actually understand what i'm saying?

TOBY awk!

ALISON

o My gosh, o my gosh. I wonder how much gold is really behind here, go again toby.

NARRATOR

Toby carries on. Alison waits for a couple of minutes checking her phone battery which is on 20%. Toby comes back. He opens his beak and Alison opens her bag, Toby places the little gold nuggets in the bag.

Beat.

Scene four

NARRATOR Alison arrives back at base with the boys.

JOHN There you are jack, why did you run off!

JACK Because I wanted to help.

JOHN Do you understand how dangerous that could have been?

NARRATOR Jack puts his head down.

> ALISON Where's mike?

WENDY Isn't mike with you, he ran in to get the boys.

Suddenly Alison panics.

NARRATOR

Suddenly Emily runs back into the cave with a tired toby following her.

ALISON Wait Emily wait, ill ring him.

NARRATOR

JACK Yeah that's what I'm always told at school. Pause.

SASKIA Where's mike, it's been a while.

Wendy slightly worried.

WENDY I'm sure he'll be back soon.

Slight pause.

He's probably found something interesting to do, you know what men are like.

Slight pause. O, I suppose you don't yet.

Slight pause. If boys are your thing, of course.

Wendy awkwardly smiles.

EMILY Mum said dad will be back soon, so nothing to worry about.

Wendy looks concerned.

John comes down the stairs.
