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1 EXT. INDUSTRIAL STREET - DAY

SUPER: BRISTOL, MID-1980S

COLIN WHITE (21), a Black man wearing navy blue factory uniform walks down a long street towards Phenway Express, a VHS/video distributor lorry depot in Avonmouth Bristol.

2 INT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - CANTEEN - DAY

A dozen WHITE MEN sit. Some chat, some eat, some read the newspaper.

Kate Bush "Man with the Child in his Eyes" on the radio.

3 EXT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - DAY

Colin walks towards the entrance, 'Phenway Express' written in 1960s advertising.

He stops and looks at the entrance.

BRADY and JOHN (both early 20s) walk past and look at him. Both sniff at Colin and walk in.

4 INT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - CORRIDOR - CONTINUOUS

We follow the men through a corridor towards the canteen.

BRADY You serious?

JOHN Yeah why not?

BRADY No fucking way mate, not on your life.

JOHN Well that's what Trev said!

BRADY Exactly mate, I rest my case. Smelt a bit didn't he?

They start laughing as they walk into the canteen.

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Colin takes a cigarette out of a packet and looks at it.

6 INT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - CANTEEN - DAY

The door opens. Brady and John walk in.

BILL (mid-40s and the boss) strides up to them.

BILL Better late than never, what fucking time do you-

JOHN Think we've got a new driver Bill!

BILL Is that your fucking excuse?

The men start laughing.

BILL (CONT'D) Wasn't it last week that you said the misses kept you up all night after drinking too much wine?

DAVE (mid-20s) shouts from a table nearby.

DAVE Yeah and that was a load of bollocks, cause she was with me.

They all laugh harder.

7 EXT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - DAY

Colin lights up the cigarette, draws it from his mouth, pauses, exhales and then drops it on the floor.

He stamps it out and opens the door. Before the door closes, we see him walk down the corridor.

8 EXT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - CANTEEN - DAY

John shakes his head at Dave.

JOHN Fuck you Dave. Well, we are also trying for a baby. 5

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7

DAVE How the fuck does drinking wine help with that? JOHN If you had a misses you would know. BRADY There's a coloured guy outside wearing our uniform. Most of the men stop laughing. BILL We've got a new bloke starting today? PAULIE (mid-20s) calls out from another table. PAULIE What, so who the fuck is this black bloke? BILL Hang on. BRADY I'm not fucking pairing up with that. BILL Whoa whoa, hold your horses... All the men start talking over each other. TREV (late 20s) stands up and shouts. TREV Oy you, guys, guys. At least hear what Bill has to say? BILL I am still your fucking boss. PAULIE Long as I'm not on any journeys with him, I'm fine. BILL The new bloke is called Colin White, so how the fuck is he gonna be a col-The door opens and Colin walks in.

3.

Everyone's silent as Colin nods in acknowledgement.

Kate Bush finishes as a DJ starts talking.

Silence, then --

TREV Fucking love that song.

A few mumbles here and there.

Trev gets up and walks over to Colin by the door.

TREV (CONT'D) You must be Colin.

COLIN Hi, nice to meet you. My first day here.

PAULIE

No shit!

Trev laughs. More mumbles.

TREV Don't mind him, he's the clown of the group.

Brady gets up, picks up his coffee cup and walks past them.

Colin puts his hand out but Brady doesn't acknowledge the gesture and walks out.

Silence fills the room.

COLIN I was trying to find the manager's office.

BILL Yeah, you have to come through the canteen to get to it.

PAULIE Usually that's a good way of getting to know any newcomers.

COLIN

Usually?

PAULIE (angry) That's what I said, yeah... BILL My office is this way.

Bill walks towards a different door. Trev looks at Colin.

TREV Best go with him.

Some of the men watch as Colin walks fast to catch up with Bill. Trev takes a seat, Paulie flashing him a disapproving nod.

We follow Colin to --

9

INT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - BILL'S OFFICE - DAY

Bill sits behind a table, Colin sat on the other side.

BILL What's that then?

COLIN

Sorry I-

BILL Your aftershave. What make is it?

COLIN Oh, umm. Drakkar Noir.

BILL Bit fancy, isn't it?

COLIN

Umm...

BILL No surprise, but you'll be teamed up with Trev. We got plenty of stops to make, we'll be leaving at 9:30 today and ETA back here, probably 6:30. How does that that sound?

Colin nods.

COLIN Great, fine thanks.

BILL So you said you had some experience before. Where was that, then? 5.

COLIN Chartwells, but they've recently been taken over by a new company... BILL Yeah, I know all about it. Food distributors. Recently been taken over by a punch of Pakis? COLIN Hindus! BILL What? COLIN Indians BILL Yeah, that. (beat) Why did you leave? COLIN The owners can't afford to pay full time so it's a family run business at the mo-BILL So we got you instead. See. Nothing wrong with looking after your own right? (beat) Not being racialist or anything but why do we have to follow rules, whilst others can employ whoever they like. A beat -- Colin keeps his composure. COLIN I still work for Chartwell. BILL What, how? COLIN At the weekends. I also play football with their-BILL As I said, we start work in...

Bill glances at the clock on the wall: ten past 8.

BILL (CONT'D) Hour and 20 minutes. Better start loading up the lorry with Trev. Here's the lorry number.

He gives Colin a piece of paper.

Colin looks at it and gives it back.

COLIN

That's okay, I can remember the reg, XEY. Thanks for giving me the opportunity to be a part of the team. I won't let the side down-

Bill leans in.

BILL

It said on your papers, Colin White. You didn't sound the way you look on the phone either.

Colin looks hurt, confused.

BILL (CONT'D) Team player right? Well off you fuck then.

Colin gets up walks towards the door and opens it.

BILL (CONT'D) You're not a Puff are you?

Colin turns around.

COLIN

Sorry?

BILL A bender, a pillow muncher. A queer?

COLIN Gay? No, I'm not gay.

BILL Well, at least that's something.

Bill looks down at Colin's papers.

BILL (CONT'D) Close the door behind-

Colin closes the door. Bill's angry face contorts.

You.

10 INT. LORRY - DAY

Colin loads up the lorry with VHS players.

Paulie, John, Dave and Brady come out to the yard, watching him. Bill follows.

COLIN Any sign of Trev?

Some of the men giggle.

Colin frowns -- something isn't right.

John and Brady walk towards the lorry, smiling.

JOHN Cheers for that.

Brady opens the driver door and jumps in. John opens the passenger door and jumps in. He looks in the rearview mirror and sees Colin's annoyed expression.

JOHN (CONT'D) Close the hatch while your at it.

Colin stands there. Looks over to Bill who smiles awkwardly and slowly walks back in.

> JOHN (CONT'D) Close the fucking hatch!

Colin stands there. Brady switches on the engine.

BRADY Close the fucking hatch, chalky! I'm gonna drive off and all the equipment will fall out and break, which means you'll be kissing goodbye to your job.

JOHN Just drive off Brady, fuck him.

BRADY

5,4,3...

Colin quickly starts closing the boot up.

BRADY (CONT'D)

2, 1...

Brady accelerates and drives off, leaving a plume of dust.

As it settles, Trev emerges to see Colin agitated.

TREV Over here. Our lorry is over here.

Colin nods.

COLIN I was told to pack Registration XEY. The wrong lorry, I'm sor-

TREV I know. Fuck it Col.

11INT. TREV AND COLIN'S LORRY - DAY11Kate Bush's 'Them Heavy People' plays on the radio.

Trev nods over to Colin who's not really enjoying the music but appreciating Trev's company.

- 12 INT. JOHN AND BRADY'S LORRY DAY 12 John looks at Brady then out towards the traffic.
- 13 INT. TREV AND COLIN'S LORRY DAY 13 Trev hums along to Kate Bush. Colin smiles and looks out of the window.
- 14 INT. JOHN AND BRADY'S LORRY DAY 14 Brady takes out a bag from his pocket.

BRADY Come on man.

JOHN

What? For god's sake, go on then.

Brady smiles and opens the bag -- weed inside. He starts rolling up. John nods his head.

I bet.

BRADY Don't say it, don't you fucking dare.

15 INT. TREV AND COLIN'S LORRY - DAY

The intro to Kate Bush's album 'A Kick Inside' plays. Whale sounds through the music.

COLIN Interesting album. We hearing it again?

A beat, then --

TREV Kate Bush. You don't like it? So what kind of music you into.

COLIN I like all sorts. Soul, funk. HipHip.

Trev nods but frowns on the word 'HipHip'.

TREV

HipHop?

COLIN Yeah, a variety of music really, Bob Marley. A bit of pop.

TREV

Pop?

Colin nods.

COLIN So Kate Bush. You a big fan?

Trev looks at Colin for a moment.

TREV

That bit. Getting you to pack the wrong lorry. That is what we call the initiation.

He looks to the traffic again.

COLIN So what's the bit called, when Brady called me Chalky?

TREV

Racism.

Colin looks at Trev and smirks.

16 INT. JOHN AND BRADY'S LORRY - DAY

Brady pulls out a cassette tape.

BRADY I also picked this up the other day.

He puts it in the tape player.

JOHN What is it?

RUN DMC 'Hard Times' plays. Brady turns it up.

JOHN (CONT'D) Turn that stuff down.

BRADY What, you don't like it?

He nods his head to the beat.

JOHN It's alright, I'm more into Reggae music.

Both look out towards the traffic. Nodding their head to the music.

17 INT. DAVE AND PAULIE'S LORRY - DAY

Dave and Paulie pull out of the depot.

PAULIE So you're telling me we have no chance of winning the league.

Paulie laughs.

PAULIE (CONT'D) You're fucking deluded mate. 16

Dave nods.

PAULIE (CONT'D) So go on then, how do you think you're gonna win?

DAVE Ian fucking Rush mate.

Paulie laughs.

PAULIE That's what you always say.

Both start laughing.

Dave gets out a little stress ball and headers it to Paulie.

Whilst driving Paulie manages to header it back. Both still laughing and cheering each other on.

DAVE £75 fucking smackers, mate.

PAULIE No fucking way!

DAVE Yes fucking way, all the fucking way.

PAULIE

Who was it?

DAVE Imperial Black came through.

PAULIE No way, that's the same horse I choose for the grand national. The fucking Black cunt didn't win that one though.

Both laugh.

PAULIE (CONT'D) Speaking of which. I wonder how Trev's doing. The paddy prick.

18 EXT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - CANTEEN - DAY 18 Bill, ANDY (26, gay) and five DINNER LADIES including head cook MERRILL (45). MERRILL I ain't changing the fucking menu to suit any Jigaboos needs.

BILL He's not gonna last long Merrill, the lads won't have it. He'll probably be gone by the end of the week. (beat) If not sooner.

MERRILL What I wanna know is, how didn't you know the jig was up?

ANDY He didn't sound Black, Merrill. Bill wouldn't have known.

MERRILL Me and the girls will leave if he stays, right girls.

Most nod, apart from two or three that look uncomfortable.

MERRILL (CONT'D) Andy you're an honorary girl.

Andy smiles then looks at the ladies that are uncomfortable and shrugs.

TERESA, mixed heritage, looks more and more uncomfortable.

TERESA You can't say that Merrill. It's out of order.

MERRILL For goodness sake Trees, not this again.

TERESA Well what? And Lucy, I'm surprised at you. Your four months pregnant with a half cast kid in your belly.

LUCY looks down at the floor.

TERESA (CONT'D) If you're gonna sack me Merrill, sack me. MERRILL Ain't got a problem with you Teresa. I'm not putting up with this. I'm being bullied here.

Merrill walks out. Teresa nods her head in disgust.

BILL Now ladies, it seems some of us have a difference of opinion. That's fine, we live in a free-

TERESA That's it! I don't know if I can stick this out for much longer.

Teresa grabs her coat, about to leave. Lucy starts crying.

BILL Andy, can I have a word?

He gestures towards his office. Andy follows him inside.

Teresa puts her coat down and sits down next to Lucy.

LUCY Why is there so much hate in the world?

Dinner ladies start talking amongst themselves.

JANE and RACHEL approach Teresa and Lucy.

RACHEL Trouble is, she doesn't even know what she's saying most of the time. In Merrill's world, it's like whatever's on the news must be true.

JANE You know what she's like. Take no notice, Trees.

TERESA That's the trouble, I've been turning my cheek so many times I've got a bleeding headache.

Bill comes out of the office with Andy.

BILL Right, back to work ladies. (to Teresa and Lucy) (MORE) TERESA As if their wife's can't cook for them. Lazy sods.

19

INT. JOHN AND BRADY'S LORRY - DAY

RUN DMC 'Its Like That' plays. Both are trying to rap.

JOHN Money is the key to end all your woes Your ups and your downs, your highs and your lows Won't you tell me last time that love bought you clothes? It's like that, and that's the way it is.

BRADY Bills fly higher every day We receive much lower pay I'd rather stay young, go out and play It's like that, and that's the way it is

Both look at each other.

JOHN AND BRADY

Huh**!**

20 INT. WIMPY - DAY

Trev and Colin both dig into a Wimpy burger.

TREV They said it's terminal, so it kind of changes your prospective on life. (beat) Could you pass me the salt?

Colin looks. Trev laughs.

TREV (CONT'D) Believe you me, a bit of salt ain't going to change anything. (beat) (MORE) 19

TREV (CONT'D) On the bright side, I've got a couple of days off so I'm going back to Cork. COLIN I'm so-TREV With the misses, I'll be back next week. (beat) What... you didn't think I was Irish? Colin stops eating, shocked. He doesn't know what to say. TREV (CONT'D) So, tomorrow you'll be helping a different driver. That's what usually happens. On the first week a new assistant would be put with a different driver each day, to get used to the different routes. (beat) As well as different bloke's personalities and rhythms. COLIN Trev, I'm so sorry to-Paulie and Dave enter, shouting. PAULIE What the fuck did you mean by what you said earlier? Colin jumps up from his seat. PAULIE (CONT'D) Come on you fucking prick. Ain't so monthly now are ya? He runs up to Colin. Trev slowly gets up. Colin goes into fight or flight mode. COLIN Look Paul, I'm not-PAULIE Paulie! Paulie and Colin are face to face. CUSTOMERS and STAFF look on, concerned.

PAULIE (CONT'D) Go on. Say it properly-TREV Leave it out Paulie, come on. You made your point. PAULIE Go on, say it properly. My. Name. Is. A beat, then --Paulie starts laughing in Colin's face. He walks off to order his food. Dave follows. Trev gives Colin a napkin. Colin wipes his face, throws the napkin down and walks out. We follow Trev as he picks his bag up and walks out. From behind Trev, we see Paulie being denied service. Paulie gives up trying to order. Paulie walks towards the camera. CUT TO BLACK. INT. TREV AND COLIN'S LORRY - DAY 21 A long silence, then --TREV Them knowing that they can get under your skin is you allowing them to win. Colin looks. TREV (CONT'D) Bloody hell, well you gotta find some way to get along with them. I had to. COLIN You don't sound Irish.

21

Annoyed, Trev naturally sounds more Irish when he replies.

TREV What the fuck is that supposed to mean?

17.

He looks at Colin and smiles.

TREV (CONT'D)

I get it.

Colin nods.

COLIN And that's what makes you, you.

Slight pause.

COLIN (CONT'D) Feels like I've known you for way longer than nine hours.

TREV What you see is what you get, Col.

Colin turns on the radio and Kate Bush 'Kite' plays.

Colin smiles and nods to the music.

22 INT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - CANTEEN - DAY 22

The men queue up for their breakfast. Radio on.

Slight gap either side of Colin who is in the middle. Paulie and Dave in front. Brady and John behind.

Merrill is serving. The rest of the dinner ladies including Teresa and Lucy serve coffee and tea.

Paulie and Dave get served by Merrill.

On Colin's serve, Merrill swaps with Rachel. Colin notices but says nothing.

Paulie, Dave and Brady chuckle.

Colin walks over to Lucy.

LUCY Coffee or tea?

COLIN Coffee please. Actually, do you just have hot water?

Teresa looks and smirks.

LUCY Well you can have it under tea. TERESA Yeah, we add a tea bag in after. So you can just have the hot water.

COLIN Thanks, appreciated.

Lucy and Teresa smile.

Colin goes to sit by himself. He looks at the clock and the clock changes from 8:15 to 8:20.

Bill gets up to address the men.

BILL Your attention please. So today, Dave and Paulie will be covering Wiltshire.

The men look at each other. Brady and John stare at Colin.

BILL (CONT'D) John you'll be with Andy, and Brady you'll be teamed up with Colin.

Loud mumbles.

BILL (CONT'D) Shut. The. Fuck up, I haven't finished.

Men quieten down.

BILL (CONT'D) Both John and Brad's team will be covering South Wales. Right, any fucking questions? Now get to work.

John and Brady continue to look at Colin, who looks back.

23 INT. COLIN AND BRADY'S LORRY - DAY

Brady drives -- complete silence.

Colin closes his eyes.

INSERT: He's tricked into loading Brady and John's lorry.

Colin opens his eyes and notices Brady looking at him.

Brady slowly turns his head towards the traffic, nodding disapprovingly.

24

Colin continues to look at Brady. Tension is high.

24 INT. JOHN AND ANDY'S LORRY - DAY

Both laugh their heads off.

What?

ANDY You're on a roll my son, fair-play.

JOHN So go on then, bloody hell, talk about keeping a bloke in suspense.

ANDY

JOHN Have I gotta spell it out to you?

ANDY No honestly John, what?

JOHN Fuck me, how many birds have you had?

ANDY

Zero?

Andy turns to John and laughs.

JOHN

No, really?

Andy unconvincingly shouts out.

ANDY

Twenty-six!

25 INT. COLIN AND BRADY'S LORRY - DAY

25

Colin looks at the glove compartment.

COLIN

Do you mind if I put my keys in?

Brady shrugs.

COLIN (CONT'D)

Thanks.

Colin opens the glove compartment and notices a few tapes -- RUN DMC, BIG DADDY KANE.

He picks the RUN DMC tape.

COLIN (CONT'D) This album is dope. Is it yours?

Brady looks out at the traffic. Colin opens his bag. Brady looks at him, thinking is he going to steal the tape.

Colin takes out a brand new tape -- 'The Fat Boys Are Back'.

COLIN (CONT'D) Do you mind?

Brady shrugs. Colin puts the tape on. 'The Fat Boys Are Back' plays.

Colin looks out of the window towards the traffic.

Suddenly Brady's head starts to nod to the music, almost like he can't help it.

26 INT. DAVE AND PAULIE'S LORRY - DAY

26

Dave clicks his fingers triumphantly.

DAVE Beverly Hill's Cop.

PAULIE That's quite recent Dave. Wow, I haven't seen a film in ages.

DAVE No, don't tell me you ain't watch one since! What's it called?

PAULIE ET, mate. Yep. Fucking ET.

DAVE

Wow!

PAULIE Yeah and that was with Lucy.

DAVE Fucking hell, yeah. I remember that. Did you ever...

PAULIE

Na mate. (beat)

Fucking wish I did though. That was the same night she said she swore she saw Andy, early in the morning, coming out of Bill's office, like before the factory even opens.

Dave frowns, confused.

PAULIE (CONT'D) Yeah, I remember asking her again, like a few months after... But she said she couldn't remember. Suppose by that time we weren't even seeing each other.

DAVE How many dates did you go on?

PAULIE

One.

DAVE One's enough with you mate.

PAULIE

Fuck off.

They both laugh.

PAULIE (CONT'D) Wonder how Brad's doing with that fucking jungle bunny.

27 EXT. LOADING DAY - DAY

The Fat Boys album blasts.

BRADY Fucking hell, I haven't had such a fun journey in ages. You've got some great music Col.

They pull up and get out of the lorry.

SMITHY (late 50s) greets them but doesn't see Colin.

SMITHY Bloody hell Brady, you and that Wog music....

Colin appears beside Brady.

SMITHY (CONT'D) What the fuck? O sorry mate didn't know...

Colin stands there slightly annoyed.

BRADY Smithy. Colin. Colin. Smithy.

SMITHY Right, well. I'll help you boys off load then.

They offload VHS tapes.

CUT TO:

28

28 INT. COLIN AND BRADY'S LORRY - DAY

Cut to back on the lorry Brady and Colin. In silence. Uncomfortable 12 seconds.

BRADY Fucking hell Col. I'm a cunt okay. There I said it. (beat) Well, what do you want me to say?

CUT TO:

29 INT. COLIN AHD BRADY'S LORRY - DAY (FLASHBACK) 29

Colin smiles.

COLIN I didn't know you like HipHop Brady.

BRADY I love Hiphop mate.

COLIN But not the people.

BRADY Look if I'm honest, I don't really know any coloureds, wasn't brought up with anyone like that.

30

COLIN

Black?

BRADY

What?

COLIN Black people, mate... and not chalky either?

BRADY

Yeah, yeah, sorry mate. Black people. The only time I here anything about col... Black people, is what my mates tell me or what's on the news. Or, you know, TV and the like.

COLIN Yeah, I would hate black people too if I only listened to the media.

BRADY We're here, I'll warn you, Smithy's a bit of a... you know.

COLIN

I know.

30 INT. COLIN AND BRADY'S LORRY - DAY

Brady sighs.

BRADY Fucking hell Col. I'm a cunt okay. There I said it. (beat) Well, what do you want me to say?

COLIN You've already said it, now it's about taking action.

BRADY Fuck sake, I barely know you. Why should I give a fuck?

COLIN Because you give a fuck, from what I can see.

BRADY

It's not as simple as that mate, I got mates and family members that would disown me if they knew I was even talking to you like this. Fucking hell, my Dad would throttle-

COLIN

Mate. I don't expect us to be best friends or anything. But you know what's right and what's wrong. (pointing to his heat) In here bud. You know it.

BRADY I should have said something to fucking Smithy.

COLIN I got the perfect tune for that.

He puts a tape in. LL cool J 'Rock the Bells' plays.

Brady starts nodding to the music as does Colin.

Brady looks at Colin, smiles, then looks out to the traffic. Both enjoying the vibe.

Brady whips out a pre-made spliff.

BRADY What aftershave do you use? It's fucking lovely.

Colin nods in approval.

31 INT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - LOADING BAY - DAY

Bill waits outside.

The men all arrive. First Andy and John.

ANDY Hey Bill, what you doing out here?

JOHN Everything okay Boss?

BILL I'll wait till everyone arrives.

JOHN

Right!

Andy and John collect their bags and coats from the lorry. As they do, a few others come in including Dave and Paulie.

Paulie gets out of the lorry.

PAULIE Why is everyone out here?

JOHN Somethings happened. Bill isn't a happy bunny.

Andy smiles. John looks over to him.

Suddenly we hear "Proud To Be Black" by RUN DMC blasting from Brady and Colin's lorry.

The men look gob smacked as Brady pulls up and steps out.

PAULIE So, how was your day with Caribbean Colin? Bet you had to restrain from punching his lights out, right? Just like I-

BRADY Absolutely... not!

He stares at Paulie.

BRADY (CONT'D) You're delusional mate, always so full of fucking rage.

Bill looks at everyone. Paulie shouts at Brady.

PAULIE Fuck am I hearing, you hated his guts yesterday. You are one-

BILL Right that's enough.

PAULIE Hang on, I haven't fin-

BILL

You're not gonna waste my time and you're certainly not gonna speak over me!

(to Paulie and Colin) You two are covering north Somerset tomorrow. If you pull a fast one by ringing in sick, don't come back. The men look at Colin and Paulie who lock eyes.

BILL (CONT'D) You will find a way to work with each other. I will not have Phenway Express's reputation dragged through the mud. And I will not tolerate another complaint by a member of the public. You wear the uniform you will remain respectful. Now get home to your wives and I'll see you in the morning. (to Brady) My office, now.

32 INT. PHENWAY EXPRESS DEPOT - BILL'S OFFICE - DAY

Brady stands in front of Bill.

BRADY

I don't know. I didn't realise I had more in common with the bloke.

BILL

I was relying on you to spook the fucking spoo-

BRADY Bill, what is it about him you don't like?

BILL

(regretful)
If I'm honest, I actually don't
mind the guy, but I know plenty of
people that don't want too many
coloureds, Blacks or whatever they
call themselves tomorrow.
 (beat)

To be fair the complaint was about Paul, Paulie. We got a nice little team here and-

BRADY

Have we? I don't mean to be rude but I've had a knife in my back based upon the smallest of disagreements. With many of em.

BILL

Why do you think I come down hard on you all? I fucking know.

ANDY Take it steady. INT. PAULIE'S CAR - DAY Sat in the driver's seat, Paulie watches Brady leave. John is outside talking to Colin. Brady joins Colin and John and they walk out of Phenway Express loading bay. Paulie stays in his car for a while -- no one else around. He jumps out of his car and heads to his boot. Inside, a

COLIN But I just felt a bit awkward. Did you not tell anyone else here?

TREV

I told you didn't I?

Trev laughs.

COLIN I know, just didn't want to leave without saying how truly sorry I was to hear the news.

TREV Gotta die from something right? (beat) I'm glad, things are beginning to work out for you. (beat) Saw you talking earlier with Brady and John. That's a big improvement.

Colin frowns. Mike gets up to addresses the men.

MIKE

I will be taking over forthwith and I expect us all to work together in the next coming weeks. I have every faith that we will continue the legacy of Phenway Express. (beat, glance at Colin) Times are changing, but one thing that should not change is our values as a nation. (across the room) I look forward to getting to know you all in the coming weeks.

Applause as Mike sits down with the other general managers. Colin looks slightly uncomfortable, Paulie pleased.

COLIN Didn't think you would make it.

The area is tense but when the match starts the football thugs attention becomes focused more on the match.

TERESA Way to many of them Brady. We're just hear to watch the match guys.

They take their seats.

A Black PLAYER runs out on the pitch and the instant monkey chants are heard filling the stadium, they instantly know they're not welcomed here but stick it out.

We zoom in on one of the Bristol City players and slowly zoom out revealing a modern day kit.

We return to the crowd.

Colin and Lucy are with their DAUGHTER (late 30s) with her own CHILDREN sitting beside them.

Brady and Teresa are there too.

COLIN

(to Brady) I remember the first time I came here. I remember being terrified, well deep down I was.

BRADY Not surprised Col, we weren't exactly made to feel welcomed, were we? (beat) (MORE) BRADY (CONT'D) Still using Drakkar Noir are you col?

COLIN Yeah. Still my favourite, Brady. It's been a while hasn't it. Still smoking weed?

Brady smiles.

COLIN (CONT'D) I also remember you always having a bloody point to prove.

BRADY Didn't a wise young man once tell me, actions speak louder than words?

Colin smiles.

COLIN Yeah now look at us. Old codgers.

Both laugh.

BRADY Speak for yourself Col, you've hardly bloody changed mate.

COLIN You did good Brady. (beat) Still can't believe you're the boss.

TERESA Oh, he still reminds me every day.

BRADY You what, behave!

They all start laughing. Colin opens a can of Guinness.

BRADY (CONT'D) You still working at the school?

COLIN

Yeah, been a caretaker for nearly 15 years now. Just keep myself to myself. Don't really have to answer to anyone. BRADY Fair play Col, I know you'll never work under me. So I won't ask.

They all start laughing.

COLIN This one's for Trev.

LUCY

To Trev.

COLIN Said he only drank at matches.

Players come out and take a knee.

BRADY Wow, how times have truly changed.

LUCY Yeah we are getting there.

Colin looks on drinking Guinness.

LUCY (CONT'D) Maybe one day we won't even need to-

Lucy interrupted by applause.

Colin, Brady, Lucy and family join in. Cheers and support for taking the knee.

Then suddenly we hear a few thugs talking nearby.

FOOTBALL THUG 1 Why the fuck do we have to watch that?

FOOTBALL THUG 2 It's fucking disgusting, Black lives matter. Yeah right.

They start laughing.

FOOTBALL THUG 1 Fucking all lives matter mate.

Colin, Lucy, Brady and Teresa all stop clapping, their smiles fading. Suddenly we hear a large part of the crowd chanting.

CROWD 1 All lives matter. All lives matter. All lives matter. CROWD 2 Black lives matter, Black lives matter.

The stadium becomes hostile.
