Lovingly Remembering

Florence Landy

May 3, 1944 — September 30, 2022

FLORENCE MAE LANDY was born in Lethbridge, to Walker and Verva Kenzie, the middle sibling to Phyllis and Glen. Her early years were spent living in the Porcupine Hills as her dad was a logger by trade. The family moved back to Lethbridge in her early teen years and, leaving her school years behind, she attended beauty school with the hope of pursuing a career in hairstyling.

Florence had many suitors in those early years but, in the end, a handsome man by the name of Roy Landy won her heart. They were married and settled down to raise a family together. They had three wonderful children-Kim, Darren, and Shauna. Florence's desire was that the children would be raised with a Christian world view that would honor God, and that each of them would have their own personal relationship with the Lord. She poured herself into that mission with much prayer. Soon, the grandchildren began arriving and Florence proved to be a willing, helping hand in babysitting and general assistance wherever needed. As of today, she has nine grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Florence made Jesus her Lord in early life, but there was a period of time when she distanced herself from her relationship with the Lord. However, in doing that, she lost the peace she had known, and came to a place where she had to have that peace back. After re-dedicating her life to the Lord, she set about with zeal and fervor to fulfill the call she felt she had to the Body of Christ.

Florence has been involved in many ministry positions in the various churches in which she served and her heart to minister freedom, healing and restoration was evident. She has served as a bible teacher and counsellor and

encouraged many people over the years, and loved to share life messages, particularly with young people, wherever she was asked. In addition, Florence was very active in Women's Aglow and became president of the Lethbridge Chapter. Later she served on the area board for many years as a conference speaker and general ministry to women and girls.

Together with her prayer partner, Tsehai, she helped to found Mission to Ethiopia, a ministry that raised funds to support orphans in that country.

Florence's love for the Word of God was apparent for a long time and she gave herself passionately to the study of the scriptures and their application to the issues of life. She has been involved in bible school settings within her church as she has sought to impart the truths she has learned, as well as to offer words of encouragement for individuals and groups as the Lord led her.
