God only takes the best.

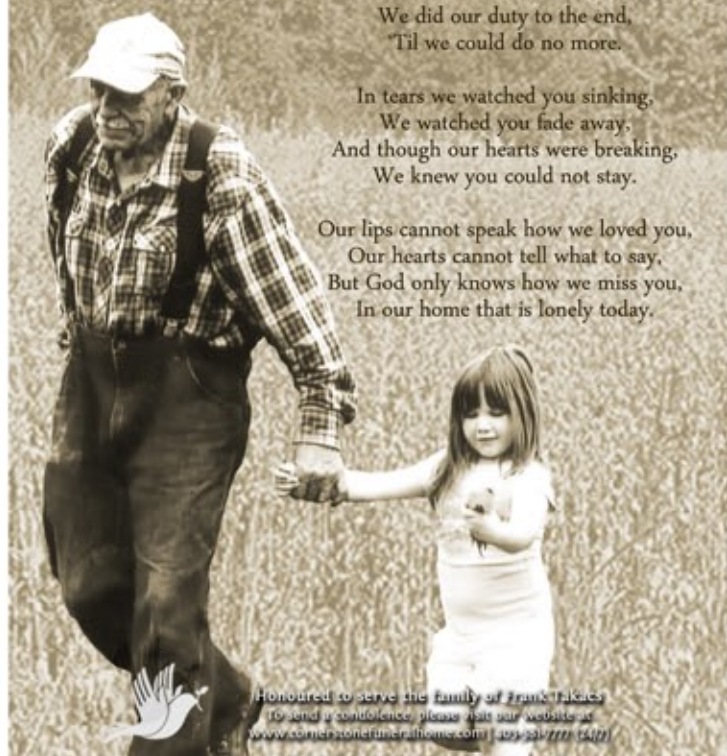
They say that memories are golden,
