Within my heart is ringing.

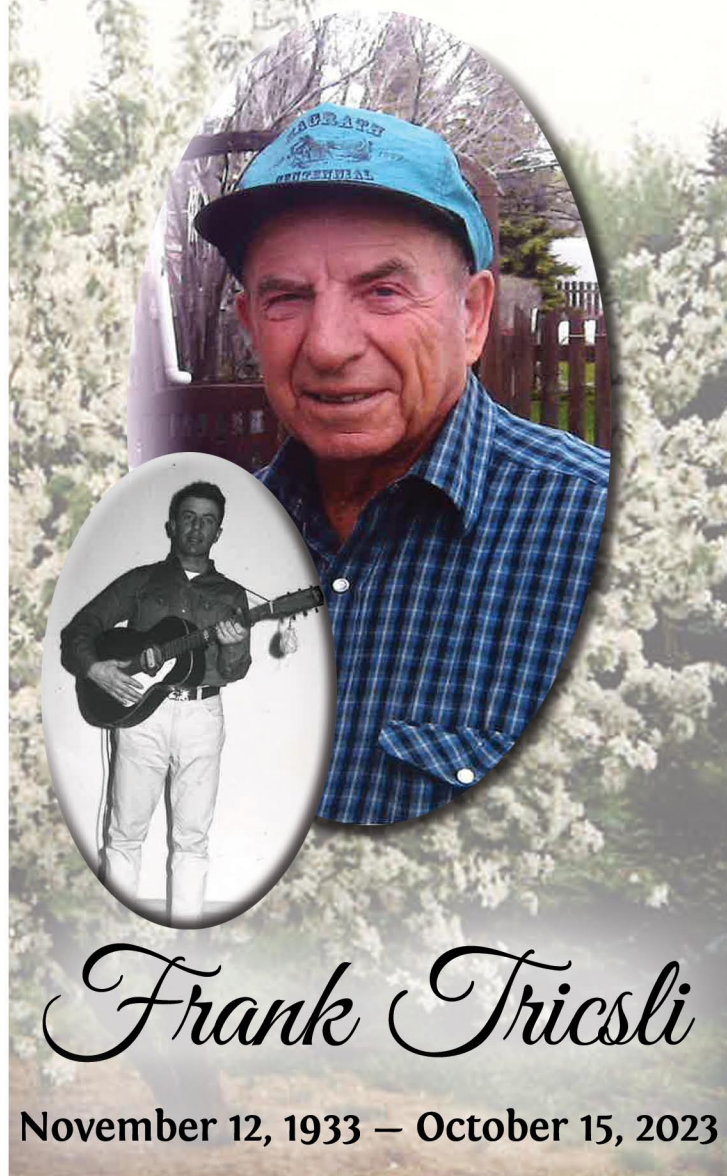
I'd stay in the garden with Him
