

# Oma's Marble Cake

## INGREDIENTS

Margarine (1 cup) | Sugar (2 cups)  
Eggs (4) | Vanilla (2 tsp.)  
Flour (3 cups) | Baking Powder (2 tsp.)  
Milk (1 cup) | Cocoa (3 tbsp.)  
A pinch of salt

## DIRECTIONS

- 1) Beat egg whites with 1 cup sugar. Set aside.
- 2) Beat margarine, 1 cup sugar and 4 egg yolks until creamy.  
Add vanilla. Mix flour with powder and salt.  
Add to margarine mixture.  
Slowly add milk mix in with egg whites.
- 3) Divide batter in half. Place half vanilla batter in sprayed bundt pan. Mix chocolate in remaining batter and spoon over vanilla batter and swirl in with a fork.
- 4) Bake at 350 degrees for 50-60 minutes.
- 5) Sprinkle generously with icing sugar.
