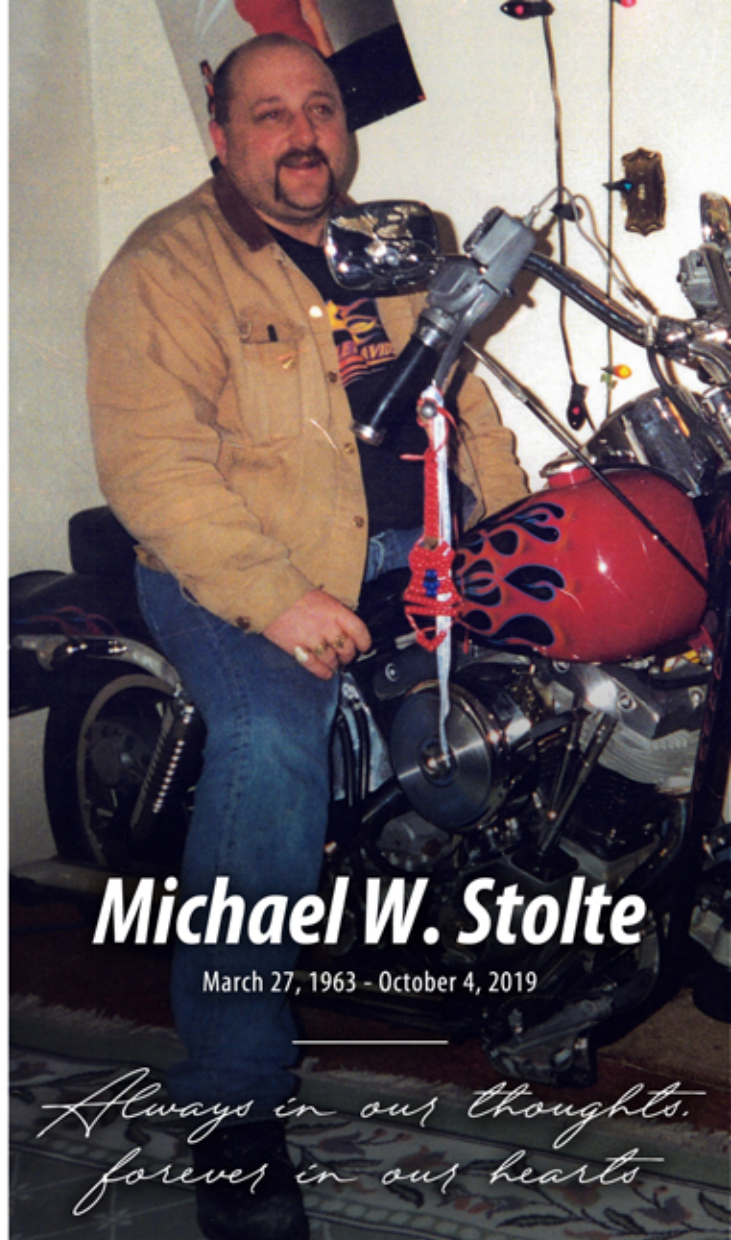


Keep riding keep riding, Get your boots on and go
