

George retired from the City of Lethbridge in 1992 with 33 years of service. Maria and George traveled extensively enjoying retired life. In 1995 George was forced to retire from the Real Estate Board because of a brain tumour. After successful surgery George and Maria continued to enjoy retired life until his passing.
