Her first job was a server at Dueet Café in Cardston AB. She also loved to cook and later and got her certification to cook for the fire fighters all over Alberta. She ended up leaving the reserve upon her husbands passing and she moved to Medicine Hat to heal. She attended the Medicine Hat College while living there and later got employment with the SAMMIS Tee Pee as an Indigenous Interpreter. The late Terri-lynn LaDuke was her 1st childhood friend, and her best friend in Medicine Hat was Karen Lapham, when she returned to the reserve her dearest friend was the late Wilomena Many Bears. Mayrose's special nieces are Kelly Young Pine, and Ayisha Hind Bull, special nephew the late Jason Young Pine, godson Michael Young Pine, and goddaughter Denise Young Pine. Mayrose had an apartment at the St. Paul's Residence where she was like the momma hen to all her neighbours.
