Butte in 1965. Together with Ted they built a successful dairy.

As a team, Mom and Dad raised seven kids on the farm. Dad  
was passionate about his faith and instilled strong values in his  
children and grandchildren. He always made time for a Sunday  
picnic, even though it meant milking late when he was tired.

Dad said the best thing about our family was "being together".  
Opa always had cookies in the cupboard, yogurt in the fridge, and  
ice cream in the freezer ready to be shared with grandkids who  
would just happen to drop by.
